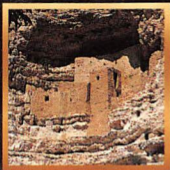

MONTEZUMA CASTLE NATIONAL MONUMENT

CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA

One hundred feet above the Verde Valley stands the centuries-old dwellings of the Sinagua Indians. The "Castle" of Montezuma Castle National Monument is a 20-room pueblo cliff dwelling constructed by the Indians around 1125.

Self-guided tours, exhibits, a visitors center, and interpretive trails offer fascinating insight to the life and times of this early civilization.

Other nearby attractions include Walnut Canyon, Sunset Crater, Tuzigoot National Monuments, Fort Verde and Jerome State Historical Parks.
