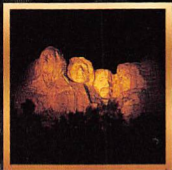

## MOUNT RUSHMORE NATIONAL MEMORIAL

KEYSTONE,  
SOUTH DAKOTA

The granite-carved faces of United States Presidents George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Abraham Lincoln and Theodore Roosevelt are the hallmark of the park which was established in 1933. Each 60 feet high, the intricate carvings took the sculptor Gutzon Borglum 14 years to complete.

More than 1,400 feet below is a visitors center featuring exhibits and a film about the fascinating presidents, as well as the remarkable process by which the memorial came about.

Various lookout points and terraces are designed to provide the best views of the memorial.
