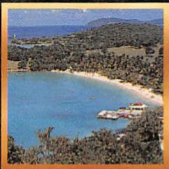

VIRGIN ISLANDS NATIONAL PARK

Renowned as a natural paradise, over half of the island of St. John is within the confines of the national park. With white sand beaches, turquoise waters, bright coral reefs and tropical forests, the term "paradise" is no better defined than it is here.

The popular beaches at Trunk Bay and Cinnamon Bay are revered by water lovers, with boating, snorkeling, and sunbathing among the favored activities.

The island contains numerous historical sites, most notably the sugar plantation ruins found at Annaberg.
