The Confederate cavalry was employed with extraordinary skill here during the battle of June 10, 1864. This site commemorates a battle initiated by Union forces to keep Confederate troops from disrupting Union supply routes.

Established as a national battlefield site February 21, 1929, Brices Cross Roads National Battlefield Site, covers 1 acre of federal land.
