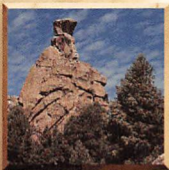

CITY OF ROCKS NATIONAL RESERVE

IDAHO

Through this area of Idaho, the landscape is dominated by scenic granite spires and sculptured rock formations. Remnants of the California Trail are visible reminders of 19th century westward expansion. Recreational opportunities include rock climbing and camping. Authorized as a National Reserve Nov. 18, 1988, the 14,407 acre City of Rocks is administered cooperatively by the National Park Service and the Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation.
