Ocean washed beaches, dunes, the Fire Island Light Station and the nearby William Floyd Estate, make this park a blend of recreational, natural, and cultural resources. The 32-mile-long seashore contains natural features such as the Otis Pike Wilderness Area, the only federal wilderness in New York state, and the Sunken Forest, a 300-year-old holly forest.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Access to the Sailors Haven and Watch Hill units depends upon water travel. These units are open from May 15 through October 15 each year.
