MOUNT RAINIER NATIONAL PARK

WASHINGTON

One of the most beautiful mountains among the Cascade Range, the Majestic Mount Rainier is the crowning glory of the national park named in its honor. The impressive 14,411 foot peak stands above the verdant green forests, cascading waterfalls, and fragrant wildflower meadows of the park.

An abundance of wildlife inhabits the area. Elk, black bears, mountain goats, marmots, and deer are commonly found in the cliffs, valleys, and broad meadows.

Sunrise, the park's highest point attainable by road, is perhaps the best vantage point for viewing Emmons Glacier, the largest on Mount Rainier.

SPECIAL INFORMATION
