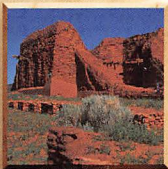

PECOS NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

NEW MEXICO

Pecos National Historical Park preserves 12,000 years of history including the ancient pueblo of Pecos, four Spanish Colonial Missions, Santa Fe Trail sites, and the site of the Civil War Battle of Glorieta Pass. The park was expanded in 1990 to 6,600 acres. Since park expansion is new, some areas are not yet open to visitors.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

A 1.25 mile self-guided trail passes through Pecos Pueblo and the mission ruins. Guided tours are available to groups with advance reservations.
