# SHENANDOAH NATIONAL PARK

VIRGINIA

The park is in the Blue Ridge Mountains. These smoky blue mountains are a special place, with forests, streams and waterfalls in the hollows, a large meadow, and abundant wildlife and plants. Season changes bring great color and diversity to the forests.

A major feature of the park is the scenic Skyline Drive, a 105-mile road along the crest of the Blue Ridge with many panoramic overlooks of the Shenandoah Valley and River to the west, the Piedmont to the east, mountains and towns.
