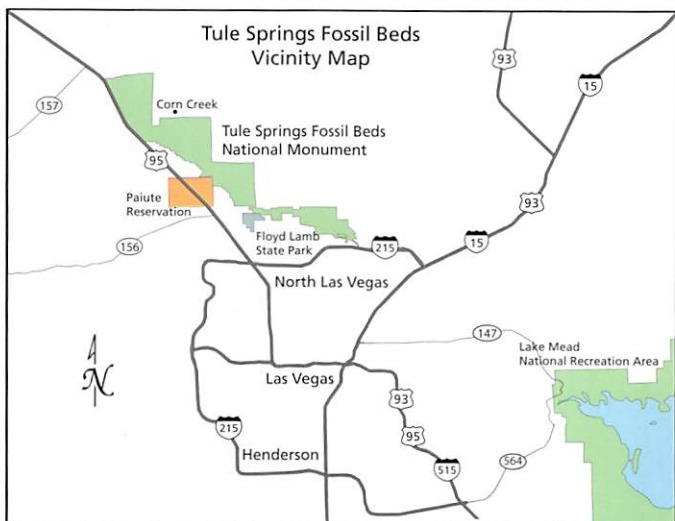

At this site in 1933, scientists unearthed an important assemblage of ice age mammals along with some charcoal, which led to the Tule Springs expedition. Since then, scientists have continued to discover significant paleontological resources from the ice age, including the Columbian mammoth, sloths, horses, camels, bison, dire wolf and condor.

Because this is a new park, there are no designated trails or facilities on the 22,650 acre monument.
