Campsite Availability & Reservations

Availability is first-come, first-serve at the following campgrounds: Mammoth, Norris, Indian Creek, Lewis Lake, Pebble Creek, Slough Creek, and Tower Fall. During peak camping season (late June to mid-August) campgrounds may fill; arrive early to obtain a site. Reservations can be made for Canyon, Bridge Bay, Madison, Grant Village, and the Fishing Bridge RV Park by calling 307-344-7311. Overnight camping of any type (tent, vehicle, or RV) outside designated campgrounds is not permitted.

Accessible Sites

Most campgrounds have at least one wheelchair accessible site. The exceptions are Fishing Bridge RV Park, Pebble Creek, and Tower Fall. Details provided in "Accessibility in Yellowstone," available free from entrance gates and visitor centers.

Hookups

Electric hookups are not available at any park campground. Fishing Bridge RV Park has water and sewer hookups, with generator and nongenerator loops available. The RV Park is restricted to hard-sided camping units; tents and tent trailers are not allowed. No picnic tables or fire grates.

Showers and Laundry Facilities

Showers & laundry facilities are located adjacent to the campgrounds at Canyon and Grant Village. Fishing Bridge RV Park has showers and laundry. It is located within four miles of the Bridge Bay campground. Cost of showers & laundry are not included in camping fee.

Camping Limits

Camping is limited to 14 days July 1–Labor Day (first Monday in September) and to 30 days the rest of the year; no limit at Fishing Bridge.

Group Camping

Group tent camping is available at Madison, Grant, and Bridge Bay for organized groups with a designated leader such as youth or educational groups. Fees range from \$65–90 (plus tax & utility fee) per night, depending on group size. Reservations are required. Senior & Access Passes

Holders of Senior and Access Passes will be given a 50 percent discount on camping fees, except at Fishing Bridge RV Park.

Campground Regulations



- For your safety, the following items (new, clean, dirty, empty, or full) may not be left outside, in tents, or in tent trailers at any time, day or night, unless they are in immediate use: food, beverages, cooking utensils, and ice chests.
- All drain water must be collected in a container. Receptacles for drain water are located at the sides of the restrooms in campgrounds with flush toilets and where posted in campgrounds with vault toilets.
- All wheeled vehicles (e.g. motorcycles, tent trailers, cars) must remain on the pavement.
- Cleaning fish, bathing, or washing clothes at campground water faucets is prohibited.
- Fires may be built only in the fire pits constructed at each site and must be completely extinguished when the campsite is left unattended.
- All pets must be on a leash, not to exceed 6 feet in length, or otherwise physically restrained at all times. Pets may not be left tied or unattended in the campgrounds. They are prohibited in the back-country and on established trails and boardwalks.
- The use or possession of fireworks is prohibited.
- Quiet hours are 10 PM to 6 AM. Generators, where allowed, can operate 8 AM to 8 PM only. Please be considerate.
- Check out time is 11 AM.
