Lottery Basics



You can apply for a permit before your trip on www.recreation.gov . Find the date you plan to be in Zion and apply.

Seasonal Lottery

There are four seasonal lotteries throughout the year: Spring, Summer, Fall, and Winter.

Day-before Lottery

You can apply for a permit the day before your planned hike. This lottery opens every day at 12:01 a.m. and closes at 3 p.m. Mountain Time (MT). At 4 p.m. on the day you apply, you will receive an email to let you know the outcome.



Print or download your confirmation email before arriving at the trailhead. Bring your ID!
Cell service and internet

connection are limited in Zion Canyon. You will need to present your permit to a ranger in order to complete your hike, so plan accordingly.

Receiving a permit grants you access to Angels Landing, but does not give you privileged access to the Zion Canyon Shuttle or Scenic Drive.

Application Fee

There is a \$6 application fee for permits. This fee covers an application for up to 6 people. This fee is non-refundable.

Permit Fee

If you receive a permit, you will be charged \$3 per person. You may cancel until two days before the reservation date for a full refund.
