## GUIDELINE issues for the year 1970.

Please follow these instructions when inserting the new sheets in your GUIDELINE binders.

In the Policy and Planning section following the last article, number 49-2, insert the first article of this new issue, "Recreation Program in a private family campground" number 50-1.


Next, after the last article in the Administration section, number 43-2, insert the articles "Some Manager's Viewpoints on Campers and Campground Operation" and "On Visitors—A Clue to Successful Operations."

Finally, after the last article in Protection section, number 14-8, add the remainder of the articles (numbers 15-1 to 38-1) starting with Records Use: A Necessity for Administration of Protected Beach Operation."

This will be the last GUIDELINE issue 9 1/2 x 6 inches—in 1971, it will be the same size as our other publications, 8 1/2 x 11 inches, with a new format.

If it is your custom to circulate GUIDELINE items to your personnel, we suggest you mark these new items with a paper clip, and circulate the books after the above articles have been inserted. When this method is followed, the items will not be separated and lost, and will relate to the new index.

1. The first line in the upper corner of the page indicates the division of the Park Practice Program in which this material is to be placed:
2. The wording on the second line indicates the section in one of the GUIDELINE binders in which the article is to be placed:
3. The center figures indicate the month and year in which the article was issued:
4. The first figure of those on the right, before the hyphen, indicates the article number in the designated section; the second figure, following the hyphen, is the page face of that article:
5. At the center bottom of the page will be found the section name and chronological page number for the section:



When writing about any GUIDELINE item, please mention the name of the section, explained in 2 above, and the article number, explained in 4 above, e.g.: "Policy and Planning, article 26."
