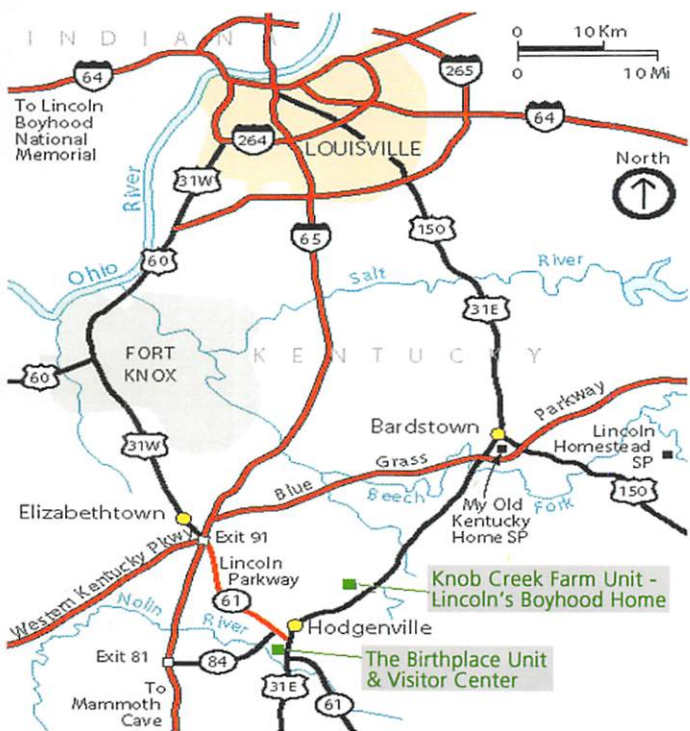

VISITING THE PARK

The Birthplace Unit includes the Visitor Center, Memorial Building, Symbolic Cabin, Sinking Spring, picnic area, and hiking trails. The short film "Abraham Lincoln: The Kentucky Years" is shown every half hour.

The Knob Creek Farm Unit is 10 miles northeast of the Birthplace on US31E. The Lincoln family lived here 1811-1816. Limited interpretive services are available.
