

Headwaters of Nonvianuk River

9 km

The 18.5 km (about 11 mi) from Nonvianuk Lake outlet to the confluence are characterized by Class I rapids with moderately swift (8 kph [5 mph]) single-channeled flat water.

During low water conditions Class II rapids may be encountered (6.5-8 km [4-5 mi]) from the lake outlet.

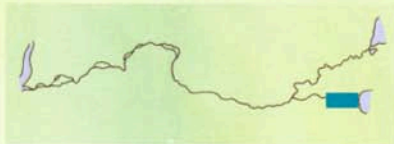
