

## **Cell Phone Tour**



Welcome to the Allegheny Portage Railroad National Historic Site. We now have a convenient way for you to take a guided tour of the park on your own, at your own pace, at any time of the day. This new and exciting method makes it easier than ever to connect to the stories preserved and told here at the Allegheny Portage. All you need is your cell phone!

Here's how to take the cell phone tour:

- Make a visit to one of the stops, located at different areas throughout the park. These will be at the park's "wayside exhibits."
- Call 814-651-9455 to access the Cell Phone Tour.
- Enter the number of the tour road stop you are at.
- Enjoy a short audio narration (1-2 minutes) describing the significance of the ground on which you are standing.

## A FEW HELPFUL HINTS:

While listening, you can access several functions to aid your enjoyment of the program:

- Press 1 to REWIND
- . Press 2 to PAUSE, and again to continue to play
- Press 3 to FAST FORWARD
- Press # to SKIP TO A TRACK

At the conclusion of the narration, you can press \*0 to share your thoughts on what you've heard.

NOTE: This service is free of charge, but your own cell phone provider's use fees will still apply.

## **Cell Phone Tour Stops**

The Cell Phone Tour at the Allegheny Portage Railroad National Historic Site has 15 stops.

## Here are the 15 stops you will make on the tour:

- 1. Visitor Center
- The Stone Quarry (on the boardwalk)
- Incline #6 Overlook (on the overlook deck)
- 4. Engine House
- 5. Lemon House (Outside)
- Lemon House (Inside); in the 1<sup>st</sup> room to left: the "Bar-room"
- Lemon House (Inside); in the 2<sup>nd</sup> room to the left; the "Fancy Parlor"
- 8. Lemon House (Inside); in the room to the right; the "Dining room"
- 9. Skew-Arch Bridge
- 10. The Park's Picnic Area
- At the Trailhead of the 6-10 Trail (Dry Run Road)
- Staple Bend Tunnel (At the arrival area, where the rest-rooms are)
   (Mineral Pt., PA) (Must drive to!)
- Staple Bend Tunnel (Near the restored culverts)
- 14. Staple Bend Tunnel (By the row of "sleepers")
- Staple Bend Tunnel (Right at the tunnel itself!)
