



Wave Watch is a partnership between Friends of the Apostle Islands, the National Park Service, and the University of Wisconsin to give boaters the information they need when they need it. Each buoy streams wave height, wave direction, even water temperature right to a boater's fingertips.







The yellow wave buoys have a flashing amber light with a 2 second interval at approximately 1 ft. above the waterline. The flag is 3 ft. above the waterline.
