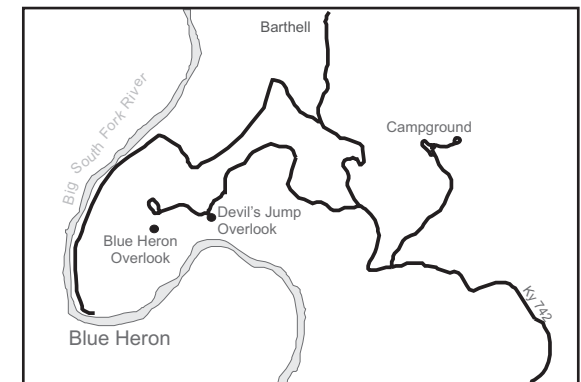

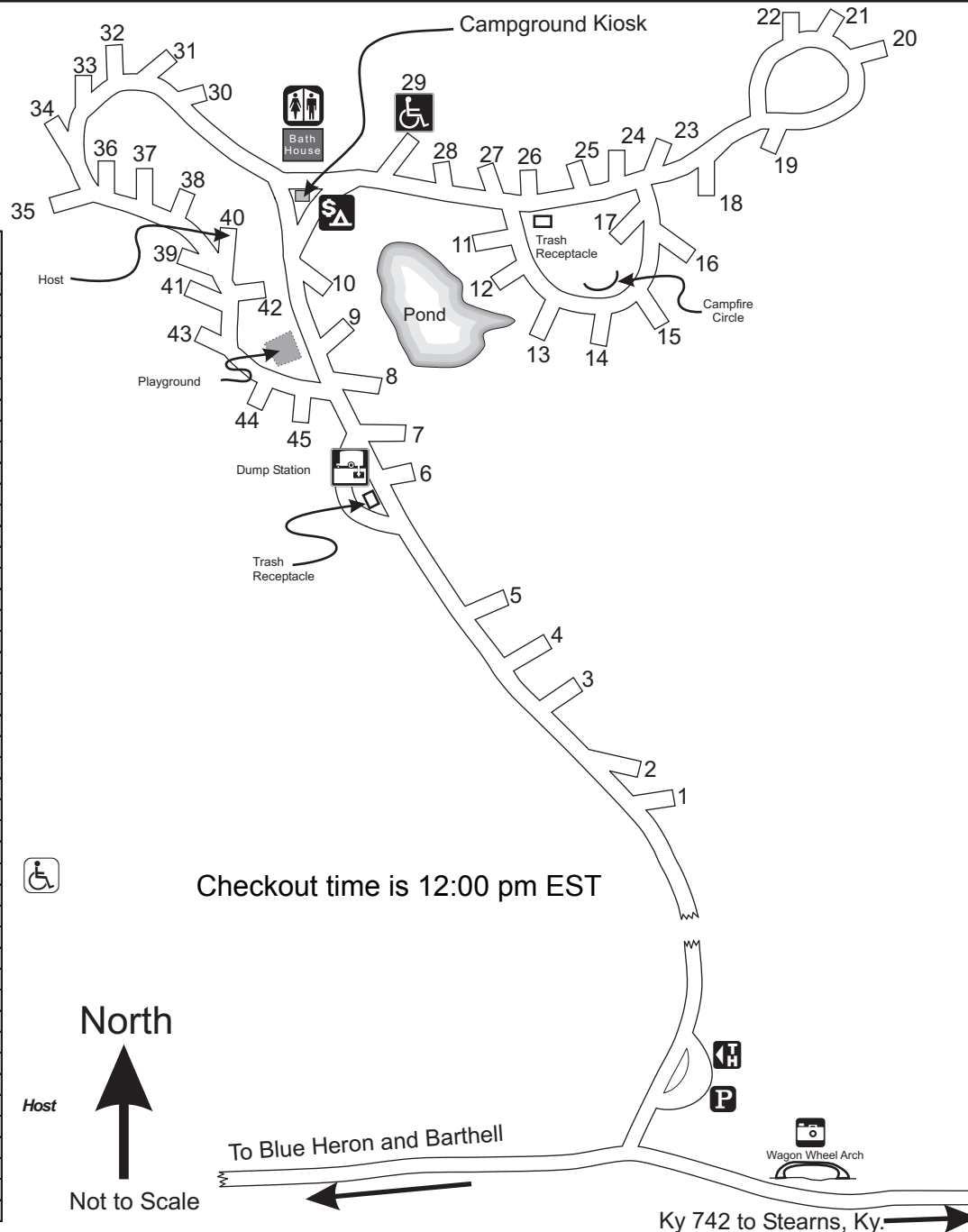

## **CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **CAMPSITES**

1. Camp in designated sites only.
2. Registered campers ONLY from 10:00 p.m. (EST) to 6:00 a.m. (EST).  
QUIET HOURS are from 10:00 p.m. (EST) to 6:00 a.m. (EST).
3. Tents must be on tent pads.
4. Driving nails, spikes, or screws into trees is prohibited.
5. Hanging lanterns from trees is prohibited.
6. Grounding for EVERY electrical appliance is necessary to prevent circuit breakers from activating.

### **VEHICLES**

1. No more than TWO vehicles per site. Trailers are considered vehicles.
2. Extra vehicles must be parked in the parking lot next to the bathhouse.
3. Parking is allowed on asphalt surface ONLY, not on grass or gravel pads.
4. Riding on the tailgates of trucks is prohibited.
5. ATV's are prohibited from being operated in the campground and on all paved roads.

### **FOOD STORAGE**

When not in use, food and equipment used to cook or store food MUST be kept sealed in a vehicle or a trailer. Do not store food in tents or pop-up type campers.

### **SANITATION/REFUGE DISPOSAL**

1. Place TIED trashbags only, not loose garbage, into dumpsters.
2. Do not burn trash in fire rings.
3. Do not dispose of food scraps or cooking oil on the ground or into fire rings.
4. Dispose of dishwater only in toilets and sinks at bathhouse. Do not dump on ground.
5. Draining of refuge from trailers onto the ground is prohibited.
6. Washing of vehicles is prohibited.

### **CAMPFIRES/FIREWORKS**

1. Collect only dead and downed wood for firewood.
2. The use of chainsaws is prohibited.
3. Build fires only in designated fire rings.
4. Leaving campfires unattended is prohibited.
5. Put all cigarette butts in the fire ring or garbage.
6. Using/possessing firework/explosive devices in the park is illegal.

### **ALCOHOL**

Alcohol is prohibited in the area of the Park located in Kentucky.

### **ANIMALS**

1. Pets MUST be restrained on a leash not to exceed six feet.
2. Do not leave pets unattended!
3. Clean up pet waste and dispose of properly.
4. Do not leave pet food unattended.

### **HUNTING/FIREARMS/FISHING**

1. Possession of firearms is regulated by Kentucky state law. There are designated safety zones, check with the Visitor Center for locations.
2. TARGET PRACTICE of any kind and with any weapon is prohibited in the entire park. This includes: BB guns, paintball guns, bows, etc.
3. You must possess a valid state fishing license for the state in which you are fishing.
4. Using/possessing fireworks/explosive devices in the park is illegal.

### **BICYCLES/SKATEBOARDING**

1. Bicycles may be ridden at night only if you have a light in the front and a red reflective marker on the back.
2. Bicycles must stay on pavement while in the campground.
3. Skateboards, scooters, rollerblades, etc. are prohibited.
