## Sergeant John Brown

Born: Unrecorded

Died: June 6, 1862 near Fredericksburg, Virginia

The lyrics of the famous wartime song John Brown's Body were originally written at Fort Warren by men of the Boston Light Artillery about a comrade who shared a name with the fiery abolitionist. When Massachusetts troops marched through New York City singing John Brown's Body, the song spread and came to the attention of Julia Ward Howe, who penned "Battle Hymn of the Republic" to the tune.
