

## A Safe Visit

**Be alert!** Don't let your visit be spoiled by an accident.

- Farm animals are not pets; they kick and bite. Observe the animals the way they observe you—from a safe distance.
- Don't overdo it, no matter what your age. Signs of heat exhaustion are dizziness and flushed and cold, sweaty skin. Alert a ranger immediately.
- Farms and woods are full of insects, and some can endanger your health.
  Report serious bites or stings to a ranger.
- Thunderstorms and lightning strikes are common here. Take shelter in a building or car—NOT under a tree.
