











SPECIAL PROGRAM:

SHIPWRECKS AND RESCUES 6 PM 1 hour. Fee required.					●		
 Listen for the keeper's command, "Open the boat room doors!" and return to the days of shipwrecks and lifesaving along Cape Cod shores. This is our 26th year of reenacting this 1902 rescue drill, complete with surfmen in uniform, and use of the breeches buoy. Old Harbor Life-Saving Station, Race Point Beach. \$5 adults; \$2 seniors over 62, and children 7 to 17; children 6 and under free.
