



Cabin Vacations At Cape Lookout National Seashore

What do we mean by "rustic" cabin?

Cabins come with bunkbeds, indoor plumbing, hot & cold water and gas stoves. There are no refrigerators. Customers must furnish their own cooking utensils, bed linens, dishes and ice chests.

At Long Point, electricity is provided. At Great Island, customers must provide their own generator or bring camping lanterns.

How big are the cabins?

Most of the cabins will accommodate up to 6 people. Although at Great Island there are some 4 person cabins as well as larger ones for 8 to 12 people.

Cabin reservations may be made through Recreation.gov 24 hrs a day/7 days a week. Credit cards accepted.
