


VEHICLES

SAFE DRIVING HINTS

1. REGISTER! PLEASE CHECK IN BEFORE AND AFTER EACH TRIP.
2. CARRY MORE WATER AND FUEL THAN YOU EXPECT TO NEED.
3. A GOOD FIRST AID KIT CAN BE A LIFESAVER—IF YOU KNOW HOW TO USE IT.
4. A HANDYMAN JACK IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.
5. REPORT ALL ACCIDENTS, VEHICLE BREAK-DOWNS, OTHER VISITORS IN DISTRESS, ETC., TO PARK RANGERS.
6. BE SURE ALL HUBS AND TRANSFER CASE ARE ENGAGED BEFORE ATTEMPTING FOUR WHEEL DRIVE TRAVEL.
7. KEEP AN EYE ON THE WEATHER! THUNDERSTORMS OFTEN CAUSE FLASH FLOODS WHICH MAY EXTEND A GREAT DISTANCE DOWNSTREAM FROM THE AREA IN WHICH IT RAINS.
8. IN VERY REMOTE AREAS, WE SUGGEST THAT PARTIES CONSIST OF AT LEAST TWO VEHICLES.
