- 1. REGISTER! PLEASE CHECK IN BEFORE AND AFTER EACH TRIP.
- 2. CARRY MORE WATER AND FUEL THAN YOU EXPECT TO NEED.
- 3. A GOOD FIRST AID KIT CAN BE A LIFESAVER—IF YOU KNOW HOW TO USE IT.
- 4. A HANDYMAN JACK IS HIGHLY RECOMMEND-ED.
- 5. REPORT ALL ACCIDENTS, VEHICLE BREAK-DOWNS, OTHER VISITORS IN DISTRESS, ETC., TO PARK RANGERS.
- 6. BE SURE ALL HUBS AND TRANSFER CASE ARE ENGAGED BEFORE ATTEMPTING FOUR WHEEL DRIVE TRAVEL.
- 7. KEEP AN EYE ON THE WEATHER! THUNDER-STORMS OFTEN CAUSE FLASH FLOODS WHICH MAY EXTEND A GREAT DISTANCE DOWNSTREAM FROM THE AREA IN WHICH IT RAINS.
- 8. IN VERYREMOTE AREAS, WE SUGGEST THAT PARTIES CONSIST OF AT LEAST TWO VEHICLES.
