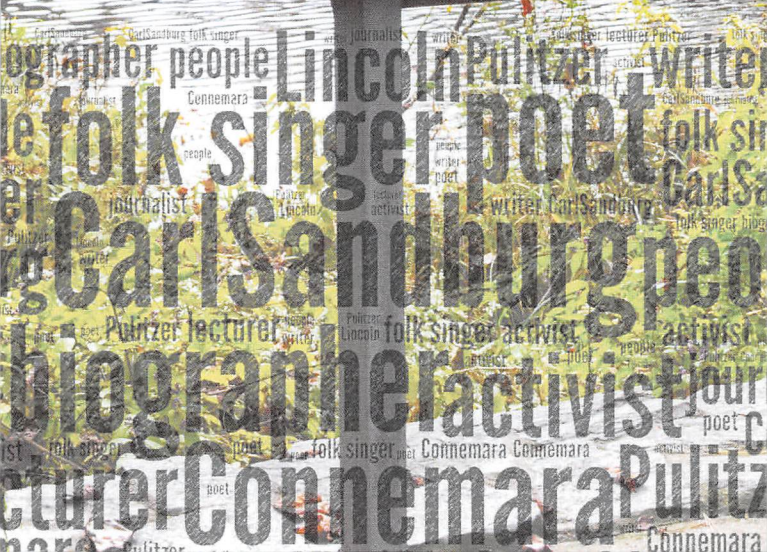

## Sandburg Home Tour

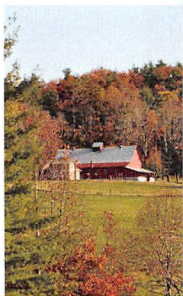
Tours are offered daily (small fee)
