TOUR INFORMATION

TRIP SCHEDULES: Several trips daily, the number depending on seasonal travel. (See inside for today's trip schedule.)

PURCHÁSE your ticket at surface entrance 7 miles inside

GUIDE FEE: \$1.50 per person, with children under twelve admitted free. High School groups may also be admitted without charge, if accompanied by responsible adults.

TRAILS: Smooth and dry. Low heeled shoes (not wedge type) are recommended.

TEMPERATURE: A consistent 56 degrees in the Caverns. A light jacket or wrap will be comfortable.

NURSERY: A day nursery for babies and small children, is maintained on the surface under the supervision of qualified personnel. A reasonable fee includes luncheon. PETS: Are not allowed in the Caverns. Kennel service is provided at a nominal charge at the facilities building. CAMERAS: No regulations for surface pictures or high speed cameras without flash. Special photographic tour available each day, for those wishing to use flash or special equipment in the Caverns.

ACCOMMODATIONS: No camping or overnight accommodations within the Park, but modern motels and trailer parks are located just outside the Park Entrance at White's City.

A FEW EXHIBITS FROM THE MILLION DOLLAR MUSEUM IN WHITE'S CITY

THE MILLON DOLLAR MUSEUM contains over 30,000 relics and antiques ranging in age from 50 to 7,000 years. The large exhibit features a \$25,000 collection of old and rare dolls, European Doll Houses; the first horseless carriage to be brought West of the Pecos, and several mummified bodies of the ancient basket maker Indians that were found in caves near Carlsbad Caverns.
