Marietta Paper Mill

From Riches to Ruins

The Marietta Paper Mill produced fine papers before the Civil War. At the onset of the war, production included stock for Confederate currency and bonds. After the battle at Kennesaw Mountain, the mill was burned by Union troops en route to Atlanta. The mill was rebuilt after the war, and operated until 1902.
