

Chaco Amphibians and Reptiles

AMPHIBIANS

Tiger salamander (*Ambystoma tigrinum*) --rare
Plains spadefoot toad (*Scaphiopus bombifrons*) --common along arroyo after early summer rains.

REPTILES

Lizards

Collared lizard (*Crotaphytus collaris*)--often seen at Pueblo Alto and Chetro Ketl.
Many-lined skink (*Eumeces multivirgatus*)--common
Side-blotched lizard (*Uta Stansburiana*)--common
Northern Plateau lizard (*Sceloporus undulatus*)
Lesser earless lizard (*Holbrookia maculata*)
Sagebrush lizard (*Sceloporus graciosus*)
Northern tree lizard (*Urosaurus ornatus*)
Plateau whiptail lizard (*Cnemidophorus velox*)
Mountain short-horned lizard (*Phrynosoma douglassi*)--uncommon

Snakes

Gopher/bull snake (*Pituophis melanoleucus*)--common around ruins.
Prairie rattlesnake (*Crotalus viridis*)--common in back country.
Wandering garter snake (*Thamnophis elegans*)
Desert striped whipsnake (*Masticophis taeniatus*)
Painted desert glossy snake (*Arizona elegans*)--rare
Night snake (*Hypsiglena torquata*)--rare
