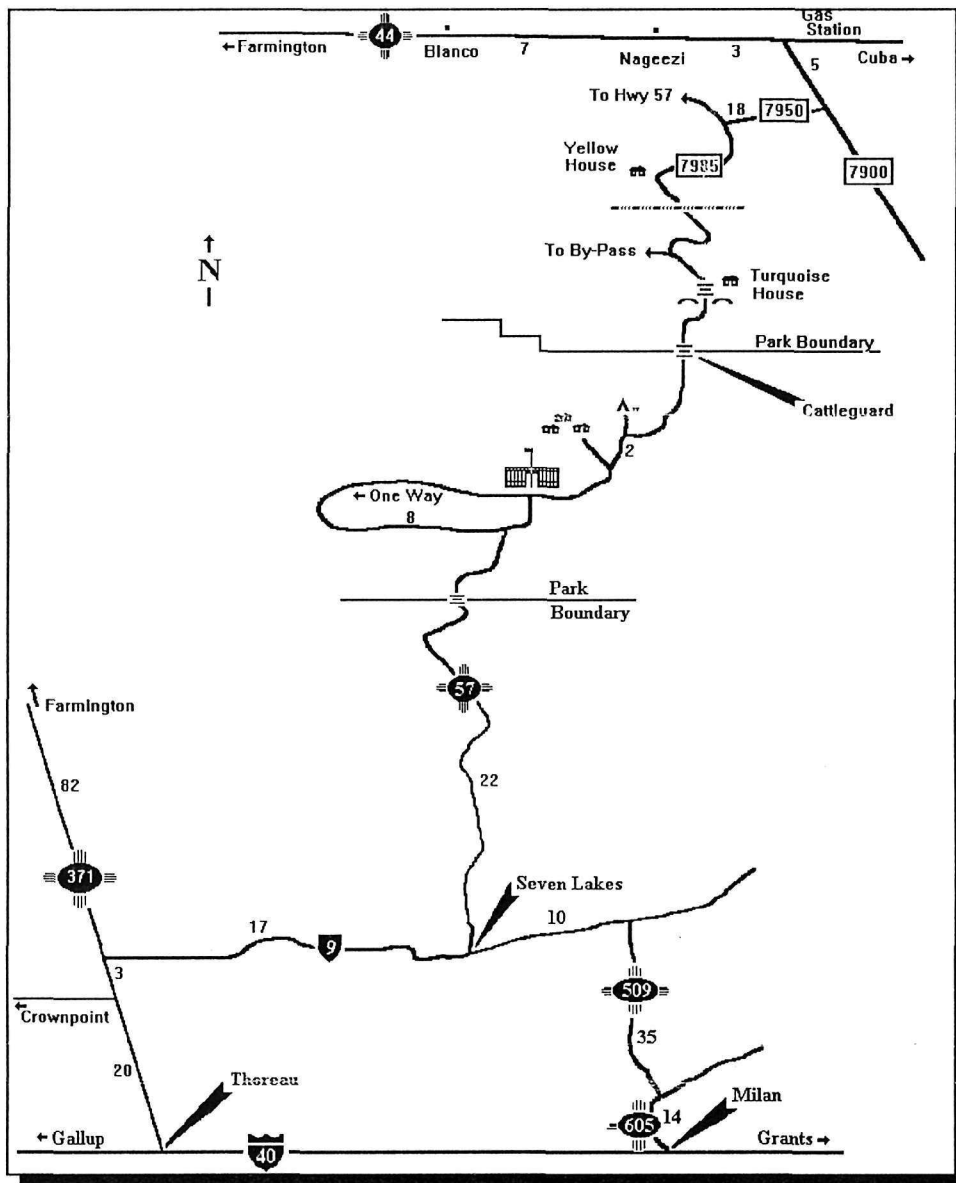


Please Make Note of the Following Changes:

TRAVELLING TO CHACO CULTURE NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

In January 1996, the northern access route to Chaco was changed. Today, County Road 7900 is the preferable route for accessing Chaco from New Mexico Highway 44. As noted on the map, CR 7900 is approximately 3 miles east of the Nageezi trading post.

This route is clearly signed from NM 44 into the park. The southern route into Chaco has not changed. As indicated, visitors to the park will use New Mexico 57 when travelling from points south. Both the northern and southern routes include approximately 20 miles of dirt road. These sections of road are generally maintained, however, they can become impassable when it rains or snows. During inclement weather, call the visitor center at (505) 786-7014 for current road conditions.



Also note the following changes in park fees:

Commercial fees are based on vehicle capacity:

1-6 passengers	\$ 30.00
7-25 passengers	\$ 45.00
26 & over	\$100.00

Campground fees are \$8.00 a night per site.
