Henry Kyd Douglas - Conf. Officer Born: Sept. 29, 1838 in Shepherdstown, Virginia Died: Dec. 18, 1903 in Hagerstown, Maryland

Henry Kyd Douglas, whose home at Ferry Hill Place overlooked the C&O Canal, authored I Rode With Stonewall, a compelling account of a Confederate officer during the Civil War. He recounts stories of the honor to serve General "Stonewall" Jackson, the loss of friends in battle, becoming a casualty at Gettysburg and his subsequent capture, and the tension of living in Maryland after the war.
