An Indenture of Bargain and Sale Between James Hinds of the one part, and William Buford of the other part, now proved to be the Act and Deed of the said James Hinds by the oath of William Hall and John Weir, Witnesses thereto, and ordered to be certified.

The Surveyor of this County in pursuance to a former Order of this Court returned into Court the Report of the Extension of the County line between this County and Green County from Green River to the Indian Boundary, which is ordered to be recorded, and which is in these words to wit. "Lincoln County to wit In pursuance of the annexed Order of Court I have continued the County line agreeable to said Order. Beginning at a Buck on the North side of Green River thence South forty five Degrees East twenty and one half Miles to ^{Cumberland} River, continued in all thirty five and three quarters Miles, to two White Oaks on the Indian Boundary line, on the West of the little South Fork of Cumberland River." The Commissioners appointed to settle with Jonathan Forbis Esquire Sheriff of this County, for the County Levy of the year 1794, Reported, that there is due the County out of the Levy aforesaid. Four Pounds, Nine Shillings, and seven pence and fourthing.

Thomas Montgomery Esquire Surveyor of this County is allowed Twenty seven Pounds five shillings & six pence for extending the County line between this County and Green County from Green River to the Indian Boundary line as per his Account filed; And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County do pay the sum aforesaid out of the Deposits for the Years 1794 1795 & 1796.

On the Motion of Thomas Housford It is Ordered that Michael Keeny, James Gilmore, William Williams and Godfrey Jobel or any three of them being first sworn do view the most convenient way for a road from Housford's Mill on Pilman's Creek to intersect the State Road

On the Motion of James Gilmore It is Ordered that Stephen Langford, Valentine Harman, John Paxton and John Hopson or any three of them being first sworn do view the most convenient way for a road from the mouth of Bush Creek on Bush Creek to intersect the State Road at or near Stephen Langfords, and make Report thereof to the Court.

Joseph Welch Esquire Sheriff of this County informed the Court that the Soil of this County is insufficient

The persons appointed to view the most convenient way for a road from Standford to Stoners Ferry on Cumberland River returned their Report which is ordered to be recorded, and which is in these words to wit "Lincoln County to wit, In pursuance to the annexed Order of Court we have proceeded to view the road therein mentioned as follows Beginning at Standford thence with the road leading by
