



DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE



The Cuyahoga River valley has been known for its prehistorical resources since the early 1800's. Campsites, villages, mounds, and fortified hilltop sites are the type of occupation areas in existence in this valley, ranging in time from the earliest inhabitants (8,000B.C.) through early European contact times. The preservation of many of these sites is next to none and has caused many of the cultures that once existed have only one or two known occupation sites still partially intact.

The Barker Village Site has been recognized as a prehistoric village in print since 1881 in William Perrin's <u>History of Summit County</u>, <u>Ohio</u>. Perrin reports that when the Ohio Canal was cut throuth this area, it exposed an unknown number of human sheletons. This cut was made through the extreme eastern portion of the bluff and site. Additionally, when the railroad (Baltimore and Ohio) was put through, thirty to forty human skeletons were also removed from the Barker Village Site bluff. No further record of these skeletons has been kept and there whereabouts is unknown.



saplings growing on the site are evidence of this fact.

Only two small testing operations have been recorded for this site. In 1966 Gary Biro of Peninsula, Ohio put three test pits into the village area and removed only broken fragments of cracked animal bone. Also in 1966 Steve Fuller of Stow, Ohio put in a test trench on the eastern central portion of the site. Through his efforts, triangular flint projectile points, bone beads, worked slate, and much shell tempered ceramics were recovered. The material was recovered from several trash and fire pits exposed during this limited testing. He also recovered one child burial. From the materials recovered, it appears that the site was occupied during a later stage of the Whittlesey Phase. This would give it a date of about A.D. 1200 on.

#### STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Barker Village Site is one of many occupation areas recorded in the Cuyahoga River valley for prehistoric cultures. The preservation of many of these sites range from excellant to completely destroyed. Within the last ten years at least five late prehistoric sites have been subject to partial to complete destruction. Fortunately, the Barker Village Site is not one of these sites. For the Middle and Late Whittlesey periods in the Cuyahoga River Valley only a handful of sites are known. Therefore, the Barker Village Site is an important prehistoric occupation site to protect for it represents a culture with only a few examples of its remains left. From the preliminary reports of the site from Perrin (1881) and Fuller (1967) it appears as though the site may be one of the largest prehistoric villages from this time period in the valley.

There is no doubt that much information and remains are buried below the plow zone at Barker Village Site. The testing by Steve Fuller was extremely good for an amateur archaeologist and his records are sufficient to positively identify both firepits and trash pits. With the amount of human remains removed from the site, it is quite evident that the area was occupied for an extensive period of time. Careful examination of this village site could provide prehistorians with an excellant picture of the culture that inhabited the Cuyahoga River valley during late prehistoric times.

It is hoped that the placing of the Barker Village Site on the National Register of Historic Places will aide in the preservation of this important link to Ohio's past.
