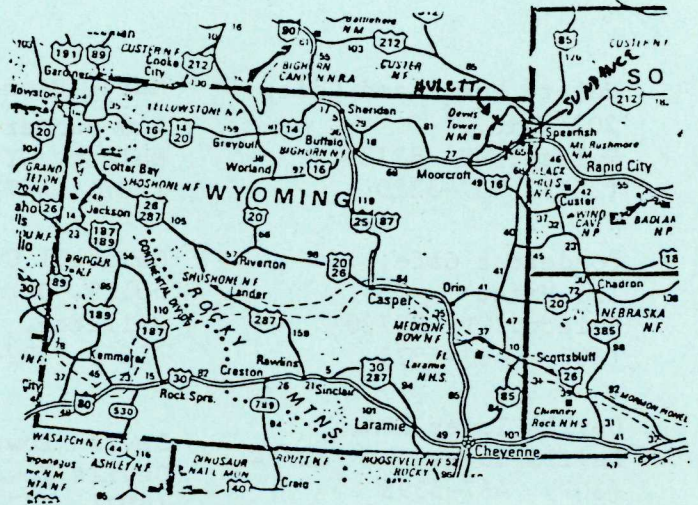
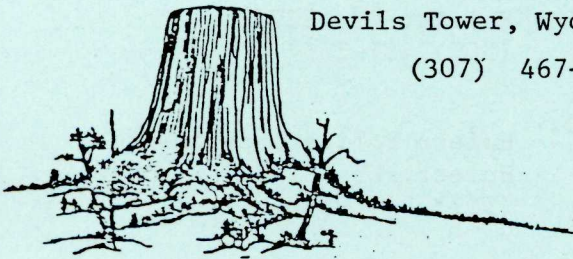


DEVILS TOWER NATIONAL MONUMENT

Devils Tower National Monument, the First National Monument, created on Sept. 24, 1906, by President Theodore Roosevelt, is located in the Northeast corner of the State of Wyoming, in Crook County.

The small community of Devils Tower is immediately outside the Monument entrance, Hulett is 9 miles to the north. Going south on S.R. 24, about 6 miles, is Mateo Village at the junction of S.R.24 and US 14. To the east, some 27 miles from the Monument, is the town of Sundance. Farther to the east, in So. Dakota, is Rapid City. Going west from Mateo Village, 32 miles from the Monument, brings us to the town of Moorcroft. Farther west on I-90, is Gillette, 65 miles from the Monument.

During the summer, Devils Tower National Monument offers: The Visitor Center, hiking 7 miles of trails, climbing on the Tower, bird watching, wildlife and photography, along with fishing and tubing in the Belle Fourche River. We have evening campfire programs near the campground. In or near the Visitor Center, are climbing demonstrations. Winter activities include cross-country skiing and climbing.

The Monument campground is available on a first-come, first-served basis. NO RESERVATIONS. Fee: \$6.00 per site, per night, with a 14 day stay limit. Tents, or RV up to 35' length. If camping in the Park, it would be advisable to enter with empty holding tank and full water tank. However, drinking water is available. Dump stations outside the Park listed above.

Handicap facilities available at Picnic Area, Administration Building and partial facilities in campground.
