Annual Schedule & Events Memorial Weekend (Sat, Sun & Mon) Ft. Larned presents the largest living history event in western Kansas--experience a working frontier fort.

Labor Day Weekend (Sat, Sun & Mon) Come visit while reenactors bring the fort back to life for the holiday weekend.

Candlelight Tour (2nd Saturday of October) Entertaining evening tours with vignettes from the Fort's history. Reservations open two weeks prior.

Christmas Past (2nd Saturday of December) Free evening, old-fashioned Yuletide celebration with hot apple cider, cookies, and Christmas carols.
