In Waterton Lakes National Park, Alberta, the stately Prince of Wales Hotel offers unparalleled views and Afternoon Tea served in a British-style atmosphere.


Cancellation Policy

Deposits are non-refundable if the reservation(s) is cancelled after 5:00 PM MDT 72 hours (3 days) prior to arrival date. 

About The Lake McDonald Lodge, Cabins, & Motor Inn.

Located 10 miles inside Glacier National Park's west entrance on the Going-to-the-Sun Road, the Lake McDonald complex is nestled on the shores of the largest lake inside the park.

This picturesque location on the northern shore of beautiful Lake McDonald has 100 guest rooms split between the three story main

lodge, a row of duplex-style cabins, and a two-story motor inn. Main Lodge rooms are located on the second and third floors. Large/Small Cabin rooms are located along a tree-lined pathway adjacent to the Lodge. Each cabin room shares a common wall, however there are no connecting doors between cabin rooms. All rooms have a private bathroom. The 1950's style two-story motor inn unit is located in walking

distance from the main lodge and directly behind

the General Store. All guest rooms at Lake McDonald are rustic, yet comfortable. In keeping in the era in which all the rooms were built, they offer guests modest amenities. Televisions, air conditioning, internet access, and elevators are not available.

A limited number of ADA- accessible rooms are available and are booked based on space available. Only designated guide, service, and/or hearing companion animals are allowed in the hotel. All rooms

and facilities are non-smoking, have direct-dial telephones, standard double and/or twin beds, and a private bathroom.



About The Glacier Park Lodge.

Built in 1912, Glacier Park Lodge is nestled in East Glacier Park, MT situated on the Blackfeet Indian Reservation. Its close proximity to Glacier National Park and east Glacier train station makes this 161 room lodge a wonderful Montana destination. Great Northern Wing Rooms, Main Lodge Rooms, suites, and family rooms are all available.

Great Northern Wing Rooms are connected to the main lobby by a breezeway which offers a cozy area for writing or playing table games, reading, or just enjoying the scenic view.

The section of the Lodge containing the lobby and dining room was erected in 1912-1913 and opened to guests on June 15, 1913. The immense timbers that support the Lodge were probably

500 to 800 years old when they were cut and all of them retain their bark. There are 60 of them, 36 to 42 inches in diameter and 40 feet long. The timbers in the lobby are Douglas fir

and the verandahs are supported by Cedars from Washington. The Blackfeet, awed by the size of the timbers called it "Omahkoyis" or "Big Tree Lodge".

Glacier Park Lodge features the Great Northern Dining Room, Empire Bar, Empire Cafe Espresso Stand, gift shop highlighting local Blackfeet crafts, Red Bus Tours, an outdoor swimming pool, a nine-hole golf course, a nine-hole pitch 'n putt course, and Remedies Day Spa.

All guest rooms have private bathrooms, direct dial telephones, queen, double,


and/or twin beds. A limited number of family rooms, suites, and ADA-accessible rooms are available and are booked based on space available. Only designated guide, service, and/or hearing companion animals are allowed in the Lodge. Televisions, air conditioning, internet access, and elevators are not available. All rooms and facilities are non-smoking, except for designated smoking areas located throughout the property.

Many Glacier Hotel




About Many Glacier Hotel

Located 12 miles west of Babb, MT in the northeast corner of Glacier National Park and one mile from Swiftcurrent Motor Inn, Many Glacier Hotel is located in the "Switzerland of North America." Built by the Great Northern Railway in 1914, Many Glacier Hotel is situated on the shores of Swiftcurrent Lake and rests at the base of Mt. Grinnell inside Glacier National Park.

The hotel offers a fine dining restaurant serving all meals, lounge, afternoon fondue, gift shop, snack shop, and espresso stand. Red Bus tours, boat cruises, and other activities, including David Walburn's evening entertainment are available at this Swiss-style lodge.

This secluded, five-story hotel contains 214 guest rooms within two large chalets offering lakeside, standard, and value

accommodations. All guest rooms at Many Glacier Hotel are rustic, yet comfortable. In keeping with the era in which the hotel was built, the rooms offer guests modest amenities and old-world style accommodations. There are no televisions, air conditioning, or internet access. All rooms have private bathrooms, direct dial telephones, standard double and/or twin beds. Guest rooms and hotel facilities are all non-smoking. A limited number of suites, family rooms, and ADA-accessible rooms are available and are booked based on space available. Only designated guide, service, and/or hearing companion animals are allowed in the hotel.



Built in 1914, Many Glacier Hotel is situated on the shores of Swiftcurrent Lake and rests at the base of Mt. Grinnell inside Glacier National Park.





Completed in July 1927, the Prince of Wales Hotel is located on the bluff overlooking picturesque Waterton Lakes and the township of




Waterton, Alberta Canada. This stately hotel, named after Prince Edward, offers 86 guest rooms and a traditional British atmosphere complete with Afternoon Tea, the Royal Stewart Dining Room, Windsor Lounge, and the distinctive gift shop, Princess Gifts.

This seven-story hotel offers a variety of accommodations including king, queen, double, and/or twin bedding arrangements. Guests have a choice

of lakeside, standard, or value rooms. There are two family rooms located on the sixth-floor of the hotel and the Prince and Princess suites on the third-floor. Unfortunately, there are no Handicap

accessible rooms, however, there is an elevator for the first four floors of guest rooms. Televisions, air conditioning, and internet access are not available and all rooms are non-smoking. Pets that do not serve as a medical necessity are not permitted in the hotel.







About Rising Sun Motor Inn & Cabins

Located 6 miles west of St. Mary Visitor's Center along the Going-tothe-Sun Road inside Glacier National Park, Rising Sun Motor Inn and Cabins sits adjacent to spectacular St. Mary Lake and is surrounded by soaring mountain peaks. Built in 1940, this 72 unit property is comprised of cabins and motor inn rooms. There is also a full service restaurant called Two Dog Flats Grill, campstore, and gift shop. Red

Bus tours, boat cruises, and numerous other activities are available at this centralized location.


The Rising Sun complex houses duplexstyle cabins, 2 motor inn buildings, and 9 camp store motel rooms.

The Motor Inn rooms are located on the hillside overlooking the complex and features motel-style accommodations with outside room access. Store

motel rooms are motel-style accommodations located in the same building as the camp store with a shared interior hallway. Cabin rooms are duplex-style and located along the winding roadway through the complex.

Double and/or twin bedding accommodations are available. All guest rooms at Rising Sun Motor Inn and Cabins are rustic, yet

comfortable. In keeping with the era in which the rooms were built, there are no televisions, air conditioning, in-room telephones, or internet access. There are however, private bathrooms in all guest rooms. A limited number of ADA-accessible rooms are available and are booked based on space available. Only designated guide, service, and/or hearing companion animals are allowed in facilities. All rooms and facilities are non-smoking.



About Swiftcurrent Motor Inn & Cabins

Swiftcurrent Motor Inn is located one mile from Many Glacier Hotel and is a hiker's paradise with trailheads for many of Glacier's most spectacular hikes. In addition to 88 cabin and motor inn rooms, you will find an Italian style restaurant, fully stocked campstore/gift shop, and outdoor activities at this picturesque location.

Swiftcurrent is the stepping-off place for the trail that leads over Swiftcurrent Pass. Trails also lead to Iceberg Lake, Ptarmigan Lake, and the unique 183-foot Ptarmigan Tunnel that was constructed for

use by horseback riders as well as hikers. It is 6 feet wide, 9 feet tall, and has an arched ceiling. Swiftcurrent is truly a hiker's paradise.


Swiftcurrent Motor Inn consists of rooms divided between three individual motel-style units with outside access. Pinetop Motel rooms are located in one long building and are accessed by a central hallway. Individual room cabins are arranged in circles and

available with or without a private bathroom. A bathroom and shower facility is conveniently located within walking distance

from the cabin circles. All cabins are heated and those without a private bath do have a private sink with cold running water. All guest rooms are provided sheets, towels, blankets, pillows, and basic amenities. Swiftcurrent Motor Inn and Cabins also offers laundry facilities for a minimal fee.

A limited number of ADA-accessible motel rooms are available and are booked based on space available. Only designated quide, service, and/or hearing companion

animals are allowed in the motor inn rooms, and cabins. All rooms are rustic yet comfortable with double and/or twin beds. All motor inn rooms and Pinetop motel rooms have a private bathroom. Swiftcurrent Motor Inn is a smoke free facility with designated outdoor smoking.



About Village Inn at Apgar

Built in 1956, the Village Inn at Apgar is located on the shores of Lake McDonald and only 3 miles inside of Glacier National Park's west entrance on the Going-to-the-Sun Road. This quaint 36 room motor inn offers stunning views of Lake McDonald and the mountain panorama forming the Crown of the Continent.

One bedroom kitchenettes are available, as well as one- and two-bedroom units that can accommodate up to six people. One-bedroom kitchenette rooms are located on the 1st floor and are equipped with basic utensils, refrigerator, and stove/oven. One-bedroom units are located on both floors and can accommodate a maximum of two people.



All rooms are rustic yet comfortable with double and/or twin beds and a private bathroom. There are no televisions, air conditioning, in-room telephones, or internet access. Second story rooms are accessed via stairs only and all rooms have an incredible lake view. All guest rooms are non-smoking and cooking is only allowed in kitchenette units.

A limited number of ADA-accessible rooms are available and are booked based on space available. Only designated guide, service, and/or hearing

companion animals are allowed in the inn. The self parking lot is located just behind the motor inn.




