RESERVATION INFORMATION

Deposits: A deposit consisting of the first night's lodging charge for each room at each location is required. Deposit may be made by Visa, MasterCard, Discover, cash or check if the check is received a least thirty days prior to the arrival date.

Confirmations: Confirmations will be sent upon receipt of full deposit as outlined above.

Cancellations: Cancellations must be made two (2) days prior to arrival date to receive a refund of deposit paid, no matter the cause for cancellation. Cancellation with less than two days notice will result in full forfeiture of the deposit. If cancellation is made prior to the two day deadline but within thirty days of arrival, the deposit will be refunded less a \$10.00 administrative/cancellation fee. All cancellations must be made through the Central Reservations office and a cancellation number must be issued by Central Reservations for proof of cancellation.

Special Requests: Connecting rooms, specific views, ground floor rooms, roll-a-way beds, cribs, and any other special requests cannot be guaranteed by the reservations office. Rooms are assigned at check-in and these special requests are subject to availability at that time.

Extra Charges: There is no lodging charge for children under 12 years of age, occupying a room with an adult unless one of the following is required:

Forms of Payment Accepted: We accept Visa, MasterCard, and Discover as well as Travelers Checks and Cash (American or Canadian)

GENERAL INFORMATION

What to Wear: Dress is informal at all times with emphasis on comfortable outdoor apparel. Days are usually warm but evenings almost always require a jacket. A good pair of sturdy hiking shoes or boots is advised for walking. It is also advisable to bring rain gear.

Dining: Dining rooms are open to the public. Reservations are not accepted. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are available at all lodging facilities except the Village Inn. Cocktail lounges are located in the hotels and lodges.

Border Crossings: The border crossings are typically open only between the hours of 7:00am to 10:00pm. Appropriate identification is required. For more information please call U.S. Customs (406)453-7631 or Canadian Customs (403)653-3009.

Rafting Trips: Available close to Lake McDonald. Inquire at Information Desk.

Lake Cruises: Available close to all of our hotels and motor inns. Inquire at Information or Front Desks.

Boat Rentals: Available at all cruise ticket offices except Rising Sun and Prince of Wales.

Hiking: Many hiking trails are within walking distance of the hotels. Maps for each location are available at the Information and Front Desks.

Swimming: Outdoor heated pool at Glacier Park Lodge. Dependent on the weather, the pool typically opens in late June.

Golf: Nine-hole course at Glacier Park Lodge. 18 hole course in Waterton.

Pets: We do not accept pets in any of our properties. Strict leash laws are in effect in Glacier National Park. Please make sure you know the laws before bringing a pet to the Park.

TRANSPORTATION AND TOURS**

Let us do the driving while you view the sights in style on one of our "Jammer" buses. These vintage motor coaches, built by the White Motor Company in 1936-39, travel over the Going-To-The-Sun Road and link all the hotels and lodges within the Park. These bright red coaches have roll back canvas tops which allow for a spectacular view. The drivers, or "Jammers" are knowledgeable about Park lore and the natural wonders of the routes they travel. In the 1920's the drivers of the buses labeled themselves "Gear Jammers" due to the fact that they had to "Jam" the gears in order to get up and down the mountain roads. In more recent history the name was shortened to "Jammers". Even though today's drivers no longer have to "jam the gears" the nickname has stuck and that is how we know them today.
