Wildlife may not know better—but YOU do! Give them room: Stay away 25–100 yards!

Seeing wild animals can be a highlight of any trip to a national park. Here are some tips to help make sure both you and wildlife stay safe during your visit.

- **View wildlife from a safe distance**, with binoculars.
- **Do not feed any wildlife**, no matter how big or small!
- Remember that **all park wildlife are wild animals**, capable of inflicting pain and/or transmitting disease.
- **Use a camera with a zoom lens** for the best wildlife photos from afar. In a pinch, use the touchscreen zoom on your mobile device and hold it steady.
