



COMMON RAVEN

**Wildlife may not know better—but YOU do!

Common ravens are highly intelligent. They can solve complex logic problems and remember not only where they cached their own food, but also where other ravens cached theirs. Ravens live in wide-ranging habitats, from open deserts to mountain forests. They are scavengers and predators, eating fish, meat, seeds, fruit, and carrion. They are also playful. Ravens can fly upside-down and do somersaults in the air, will play with sticks, and mimic the calls of other birds. Ravens mate for life.
