

## INTRODUCTION

Glacier National Park is located in northwestern Montana, U.S.A., along the main range of the Rocky Mountains just south of the Canadian Border. The Park encompasses approximately 4000 km<sup>2</sup> (1538 mi<sup>2</sup>), nearly all of which is mountainous terrain. Parent materials are chiefly sedimentary with argillites, shales and limestones predominating. The mountain ranges rise to elevations of 2450-3050 m (8000-10000 ft) and trend northwest to southeast. The Lewis Range traverses the entire Park, while the Livingston Range lies west of it in the northern section. The Continental Divide occurs along the crest of the Lewis Range. Valleys are generally 920-1250 m (3000-4000 ft.) in elevation on the west side and 1250-1500 m (4000-5000 ft.) in elevation on the east side.

The Lewis Range is a barrier, partially confining Arctic air masses and dry continental air east of the Divide, while moist, temperate Pacific air is generally restricted to the west side. Strong dessicating winds are frequent on the east slope. Average annual wind velocity at the Park's east entrance is 5 m/sec (11.2 mph). A Pacific storm track occurring along the Canadian Border from western Washington to northwestern Montana brings relatively large amounts of precipitation to the entire area, but particularly to the west slope. Interestingly, mean annual temperature and precipitation are relatively similar on the two sides of the Park: 5.5 ° C (42 ° F) and 737 mm (29 in) at the west entrance and 3.5 ° C (38 ° F) and 687 mm (27 in) at the east entrance. The effect of the continental climate on the east slope can be detected by comparing the mean daily maximum and minimum temperatures for July and January respectively: 26.6 ° and -10.2 ° C (80 ° and 14 ° F) for the west entrance and 32.9 ° -31.1 ° C (91 ° and -24 ° F) at the east entrance. These climatic and topographic effects result in the vegetation of the west side bearing strong affinities to that of the northern Pacific Coast, while the vegetation of the east side is more typical in physiognomy and species composition to areas of the Rocky Mountains further south.

The climatic contrast between the east and west sides of the Park, the large amount of topographic relief and the presence of calcareous and non-calcareous parent materials are major factors contributing to the high floristic diversity of the Park. Besides the predominant Northern Rocky Mountain flora, species of Great Plains affinities are found along the eastern boundary, many Arctic-alpine plants occur above timberline, and several species of Pacific slope and boreal affinities reach their southern and eastern limits in the Park. The biological significance of Glacier National Park has led the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization to designate it as a Biosphere Reserve.

A great deal of botanical exploration has occurred in Glacier Park since its establishment in 1910. Most of this work was done prior to 1940. Publications by Standley (1921), Maguire (1934, 1939) and McLaughlin (1939) provide a wealth of floristic, distributional and ecological information, but because of the numerous nomenclatural changes which have occurred over the past 40 years, these sources are difficult to use. The following checklist facilitates access to this information and summarizes

the holdings of the Glacier National Park herbarium. Many species are being reported for the first time.

This checklist was compiled using literature published since 1920 and the herbarium housed at Park Headquarters, Glacier National Park, West Glacier, Montana (GNP). A few collections from the herbaria at the University of Montana (MONTU) and Montana State University (MONT) have been cited. Each entry is followed by a vernacular name in English, the synonym(s) for that taxon under which it may be found in selected literature and the source (literature and/or herbarium) vouchering its inclusion in the flora of Glacier Park. Literature references are number-coded in the bibliography. Nomenclature follows Hitchcock and Cronquist (1973); in the few instances where a taxon is not listed in this manual, Scoggan's (1978) nomenclature has been followed. Vernacular names have been taken mainly from Hitchcock and Cronquist (1973). Species are listed in phylogenetic order by division: Lycophyta, Sphenophyta, Pterophyta, Coniferophyta and Anthophyta and by class: Magnoliopsida and Liliopsida, within the Anthophyta. Within these groups, species are listed alphabetically by family, genus and species.

This checklist includes 1034 species in 367 genera and 87 families. There is no doubt that it is incomplete; additional taxa will certainly be discovered in the future. Some reports herein are probably based on misidentified specimens and collections made nearby but actually outside the Park's boundaries. Nonetheless, it is hoped that this checklist will aid researchers, Park managers, and others interested in the flora of the region.
