## National Park Service

The National Park Service operates developed campgrounds at Wahweap, Lee's Ferry, Bullfrog and Hall's Crossing. These four campgrounds are operated on a first-come, first-served basis. A self-registration station is located at the entrance to each campground. No registration is required at the undeveloped, designated campground at Hite Marina.

Camping in developed campgrounds in Glen Canyon

limited to nine people and
two vehicles (excluding
boats) per site for up to
fourteen (14) days per visit,
thirty (30) days per calendar
year. Group sites are available for larger groups; reservations are required, call
Wahweap.

### REGULATIONS

The National Park Service requires that visitors be aware of and adhere to regulations governing camping throughout the recreation area.

- \* Designated campground fires are permitted in fire grates or grills CNLY. Lakeshore camp fires: in existing fire rings, BELOW high water mark.
- \* Quiet hours 10 P.M. to 6 A.M. [Designated campground]
- \* Pets must be ON A LEASH and UNDER CONTROL at all times.
- \* Use or posession of fireworks and loaded firearms is prohibited.
- \* NO CAMPING in Rainbow Bridge National Monument.

## Lakeshore and boat camping




Many visitors to Glen Canyon enjoy the peace and solitude of camping on the lakeshore. Boats may be launched from public launch ramps at any of the marinas.

When camping on the lake, the National Park Service requires that all campfire and trash disposal regulations be observed. No trash may be left on the shore, dumped in the lake or buried. Garbage bags may be obtained free of charge from ranger stations or launch ramps at any marina.

Like most other water sources, Lake Powell's water should be boiled or treated chemically prior to drinking, to ensure the elimination of diseasecausing organisms.

Disposal of human waste is best accomplished through the use of a portable toilet system.

Sewage stations are located in all developed campgrounds and for boats are located at all marinas. For those who lack the portable system, human waste should be buried at a depth greater than 6 inches. Federal regulations require the site to be over one hundred (100) feet from water. This means the site must be 100 feet from the high water mark of 3700 feet.



Some lakeshore camping areas can be accessed by vehicle. There is no fee or registration required for camping in these areas. Vault toilets and dumpsters may be available. Contact rangers for current road conditions and directions.

Private camping facilities are made available throughout the recreation area by the National Park Service concessioner, ARA Leisure Services.

At Wahweap, Bullfrog and Halls Crossing Marinas, campsites with utility hookups suitable for RV's are available. Registration for these RV sites is through the concession operation at each marina.

During the busy summer months, advance reservations are recommended. Call ARA Leisure Services, toll free, 1-800-528-6154. For reservations seven days in advance or less, call the numbers on the chart below.
