Albert Sidney Johnston commanded the Department of California in 1861. Johnston was a Southerner with a sense of duty. He left the Union Army to become a Confederate general, but not before moving the Union arsenal to Alcatraz for safekeeping and completing Fort Point. Johnson died at the Battle of Shiloh in 1862.
