

NO! You won't see any locomotives smashing together...we hope. But you will have a "smashing" good time if you visit Golden Spike National Historic Site during the Ranger Rendezvous.

Two replica steam locomotives will be operating daily through October 18th only. Movies and exhibits illustrate the story of the Nation's first transcontinental railroad.

You can drive a 9-mile self-guiding auto tour on top of original railroad grade. You will see all major types of construction used in building this important East-West link.

A 3/4 mile walk will take you to the "Big Fill" Site - a 10,000 cubic yard earthen fill, 180 feet high and almost 500 feet long.

Visitor Center hours will be 8-430 daily. The locomotives are on exhibit by 930 am and return to the engine house by 400 pm. Tours of the engine house will be available after the locomotives are "retired" for the winter(after Oct 16).

To find Golden Spike follow I-15 north to Exit 368 near Brigham City. Drive west on Utah 13 and 83 through Corinne to Lampo Jct. Turn left and follow the signs. Travel time is about 90 minutes from downtown Salt Lake City.
