Great Basin National Park

- 1. No more than two vehicles, three tents, one RV, or eight people allowed per campsite. Vehicles must be parked in established campsite parking areas.
- 2. Quiet hours, including generators, are from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- 3. Check out time is 12 pm (noon).
- 4. Maximum continuous stay at any campsite is 14 days.
- 5. Tents must be placed within 30 feet of the campsite's picnic table and/or fire ring.
- 6. Pets must be kept on a leash (6 feet or less in length). Pets are not allowed on trails. Leaving a pet unattended is prohibited.
- 7. Fires may only be built in provided metal fire rings. Fires must be extinguished when not attended.
- 8. Only dead wood on the ground may be collected for use as fuel for campfires within the park. Standing trees or shrubs, alive or dead, and trees/shrubs that are still attached to the ground may not be collected. Chainsaw use is prohibited without a permit. Check for current fire bans!
- 9. Bathing and washing dishes, utensils, or clothing at water spigots is prohibited.
- 10. All unattended food, garbage, or cooking equipment must be sealed in a vehicle or a solid, non-pliable, animal-resistant container.
- 11. Campsite fees must be paid within 30 minutes of arrival.
- 12. All plant, animals, mineral, archeological, and cultural resources are protected within the park. Possessing, destroying, injuring, defacing, removing, digging, or disturbing from its natural state any such resources or their parts while within the park is prohibited.
