

# Grand Canyon National Park, ARIZONA

## SOUTH RIM.... Open All Year

Circled numbers refer to features on sketch on other side.

### HOUSING, MEALS, SERVICES, CAMPGROUNDS

*El Tovar Hotel* ⑤. Rooms beginning at \$9 for two with bath. Dining room with table d'hote and a la carte service.

*Bright Angel Lodge* ④. Rooms beginning at \$8 for two with bath. Coffee shop with table d'hote and a la carte service.

*Auto Lodge* ③. Cabins beginning at \$6 for two with bath. Cafeteria. (Auto Lodge and cafeteria closed in winter.)

*Rooms without bath at lower rates are also available at all three places.*

*Yavapai Lodge* ⑭. Motel rooms beginning at \$12 for two with bath.

NOTE.—Make all advance reservations with Fred Harvey, Grand Canyon, Ariz.

*Campground* ② with fireplaces, water, tables, and sanitary facilities. Also camping facilities at Desert View. Camping limit: 14 days.

*Trailer Village* ⑮. Electricity, water, and sewer hookups for house trailers, \$2 per day and \$12 per week.

*Camper Service Building* ⑯. Ice, laundromat, public showers, snackbar. (Closed from mid-October to mid-April.)

### TRIPS

Reservations and arrangements for the following trips may be made at the transportation desks at El Tovar Hotel ⑤ and Bright Angel Lodge ④:

*Trail Trips.* Mule trips to Colorado River (except in winter), in bottom of Grand Canyon, and return, \$13, including lunch. Mule trips to Plateau Point,

overlooking river, and return, \$11.50, including lunch. Advance reservations advisable. Restrictions as to age and weight.

*Phantom Ranch.* Guest ranch in bottom of Grand Canyon, 11 miles by Bright Angel Trail. Two-day all-expense trip by mule, \$35. Leave South Rim 10 a.m., return 1:30 p.m. next day. Hikers \$12.75 per day, with meals. Advance reservations advisable. For mules, restrictions as to age and weight.

*Saddle Horse Trips.* Horse with guide in regular party, \$4 per person for 2 hours. Summer only.

*Rim Bus Trips.* To Hermit's Rest on West Rim Drive in morning, \$3 per person. To Desert View on East Rim Drive in afternoon (free National Park Service naturalist talk at Yavapai Museum), \$6.75. Both trips, 1 day, \$8.

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### NATIONAL PARK SERVICE VISITOR SERVICES

*Yavapai Museum* ⑬ (1.7 miles east of park headquarters). Open daily 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Talks on origin of Grand Canyon at 1:45 p.m. in winter; and 9 a.m., 10:45 a.m., and 1:45 p.m., and 4:15 p.m. in summer.

*Visitor Center* ⑫. Information and museum, History and natural history exhibits. Park ranger on duty.

*Campfire Program*, at 8 p.m. in amphitheater near visitor center ⑫. Summer only. See bulletin boards for schedules.

*Canyon Rim Nature Trail.* El Tovar Hotel to visitor center, 1 mile. Guide leaflets at both ends of trail.

*Tusayan Ruins and Museum* (23 miles east on East Rim Drive). Open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. summer only. Talks by ranger-naturalists 11 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Indian exhibit and tour of Tusayan prehistoric Indian Ruin.

*Park Headquarters* ①. Offices of superintendent and chief park ranger, open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

### OTHER SERVICES

*Kolb Studio* ⑥. Kolb's motion picture and lecture of the trip by boat down the Colorado River, daily at 11:30 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. Admission charged.

*Photographs, Post Cards, Curios, Souvenirs.* Bright Angel Lodge ④, El Tovar Hotel ⑤, Kolb Studio ⑥, Verkamps Store ⑦, Hopi House ⑧, Lookout Studio ⑨, Auto Lodge ③.

*Groceries, Dry Goods, Hardware, Soda Fountain.* Babbitt Brothers Trading Co. ⑩. Open in summer 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily (except 8 to 6 Sundays), and in winter 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. (closed Sundays and holidays).

*Hikers.* The Bright Angel and Kaibab Trails from the South Rim are open for use all year, but hikers are cautioned to secure "Information for Hikers" at the Visitor Center ⑫, and follow suggestions carefully. Those planning to use other trails should secure special information and permit from district ranger's office at visitor center.

### MISCELLANEOUS

Medical services at Grand Canyon Hospital ⑰. Service station ⑱. Railway Express Agency at depot. Public garage ⑪. Telephone, telegraph, post office, laundry, ice. Rotary Club and Lions Club. Protestant services and Sunday school in Community Building, Sunday mornings. Latter-day Saints services at high school. Catholic services in Bright Angel Lodge (inquire for times).

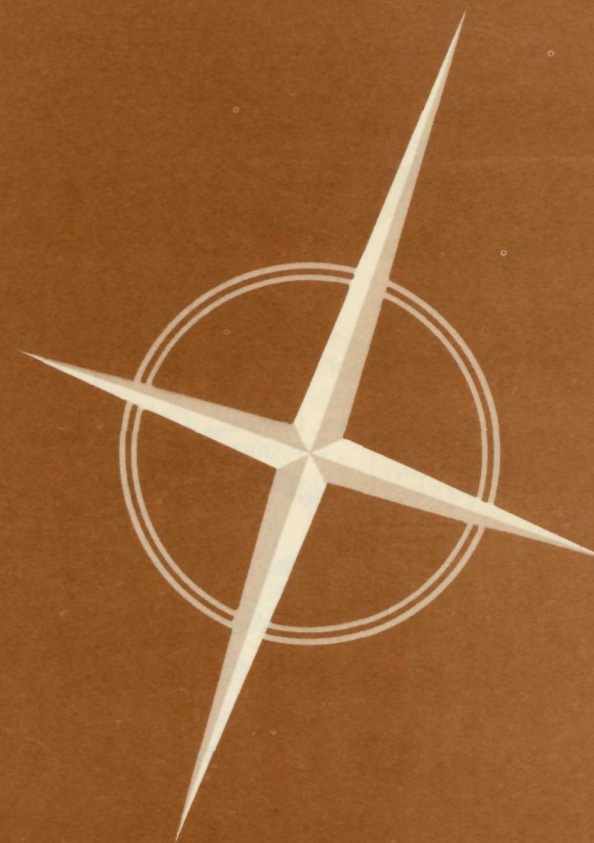
**CAMPERS:** Be certain your campfires are out when you leave them!

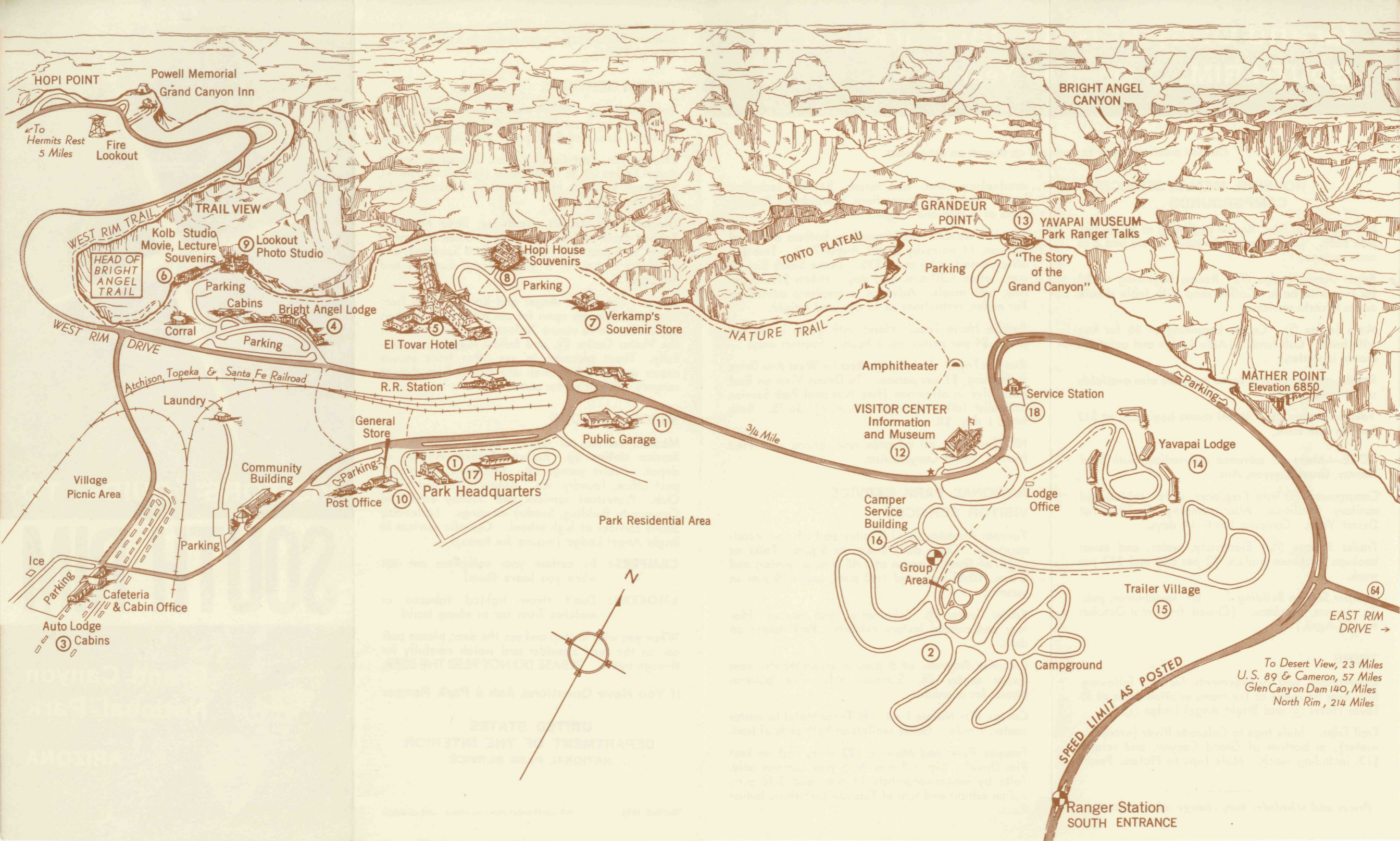
