ACCOMMODATIONS IN ALL THREE PARKS

Each cabin is right on the park grounds, so you do not have to drive to enjoy the spectacular scenery. Just outside your door are winding paths and trails, massive stone edifices, silent forests and the endless western sky. You may choose from three cabin styles. Each style has complete and modern conveniences.

FRONTIER CABINS: Outside, you'll find towering trees and canyon walls. Inside, you'll find a double and single bed, carpeting, individual heating and shower.

PIONEER CABINS: This setting offers you privacy, yet all cabins are conveniently close to the main lodge. Each cabin houses four single beds, heating units and shower.

WESTERN CABINS: The unforgettable faces of the canyon are at your doorstep. Each Western cabin

features two double beds, carpeting, private porch, a bathtub, shower, and telephone. The classic high-pitched roof that you will see on some cabins is a throw-back to another era.

MOTEL UNITS (GRAND CANYON ONLY): The Grand Canyon units include two double beds, carpeting, shower, oak furniture and a setting that is famous throughout the world.

FINE DINING: In all three parks, you will enjoy fine restaurants with friendly service, appetizing meals and picturesque surroundings.

FEATURES YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

NATIVE HANDICRAFTS: Each park also features a souvenir store with authentic merchandise, including Indian Jewelry, turquoise, silver and rugs.

IN-PARK TOURS: Tours are scheduled throughout the day in each park, departing conveniently from the lodge.

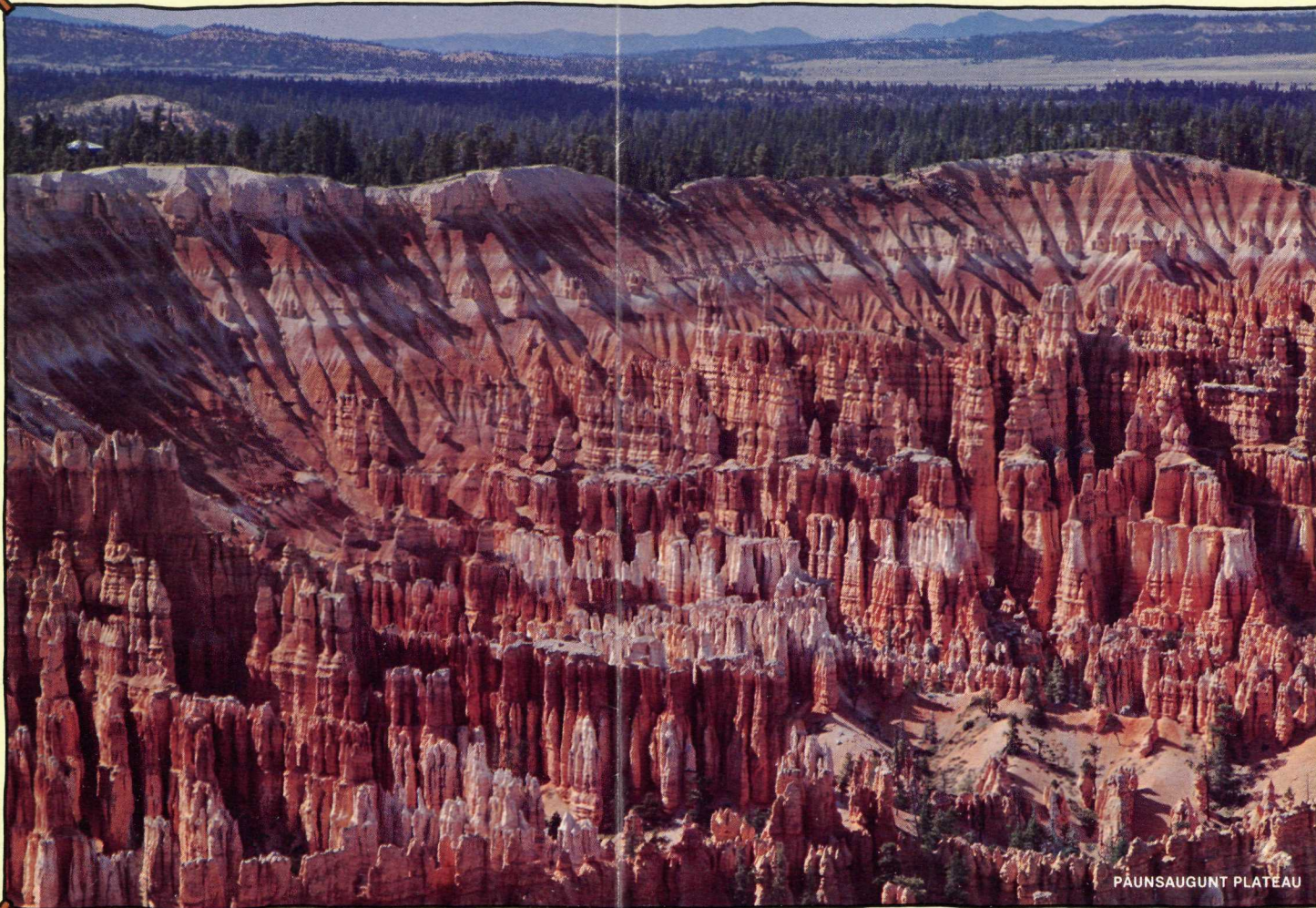
Accommodations and facilities are available from mid-May into October.

PAUNSAUGUNT PLATEAU

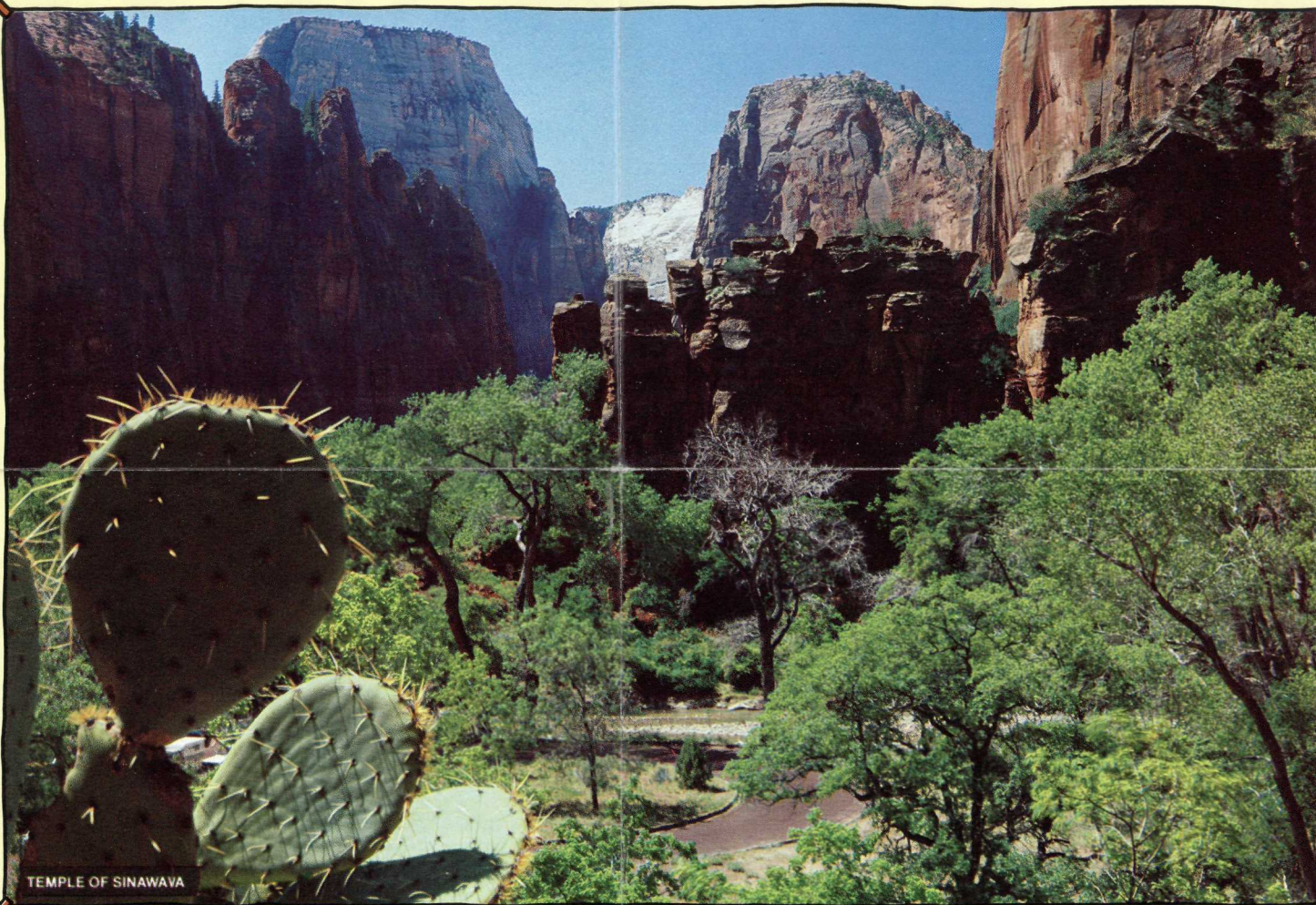
BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK

Visitors approach the rim of spectacular Bryce Canyon through forests of ponderosa pine, spruce, fir and aspen.

As you reach "The Pink Cliff" edge, a vast amphitheatre comes into view: free-standing spires, tableaux, sculptured pinnacles and multi-colored minarets create a fantasy-land for photographers and nature lovers.

A series of trails enable you to wander down along the delicately carved rock sculptures of the inner canyon.

The ever-changing effects of light on Bryce are spellbinding. Dawn and dusk, especially, produce visual effects that go far beyond one's imagination.

ZION NATIONAL PARK

Unlike the ornamental spires of Bryce, Zion is massive, rugged. Stone steps lead to a half-mile trail which overlooks the canyon. Foliage and wildlife abound. The Virgin River courses its way throughout the park.

However, Zion is not only a region of scenic beauty. A fascinating geological history is also evident here.

At times, it was covered by the sea, at times broad rivers flowed along its surfaces and still other times, it was swept by desert winds.

Today, natural rock formations like Checkerboard Mesa and Angel's Landing are awe-inspiring monuments to time and its effects.
