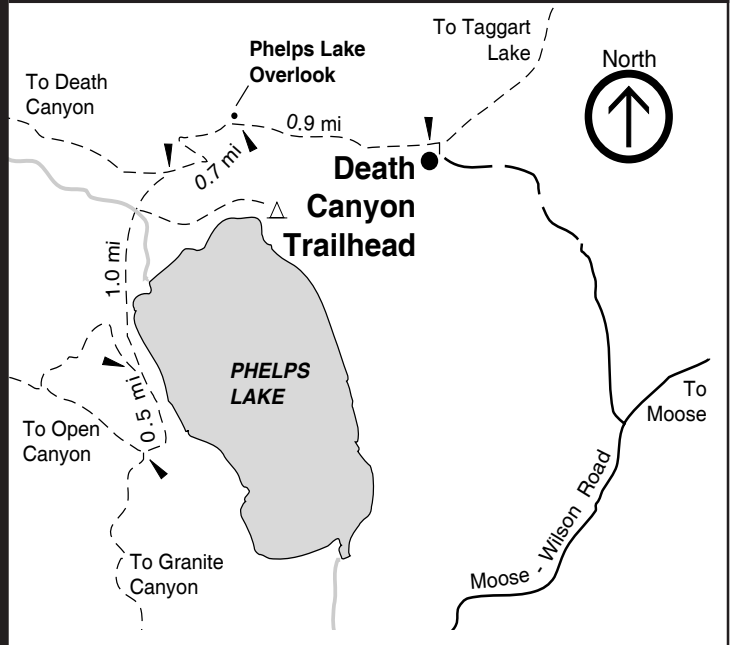

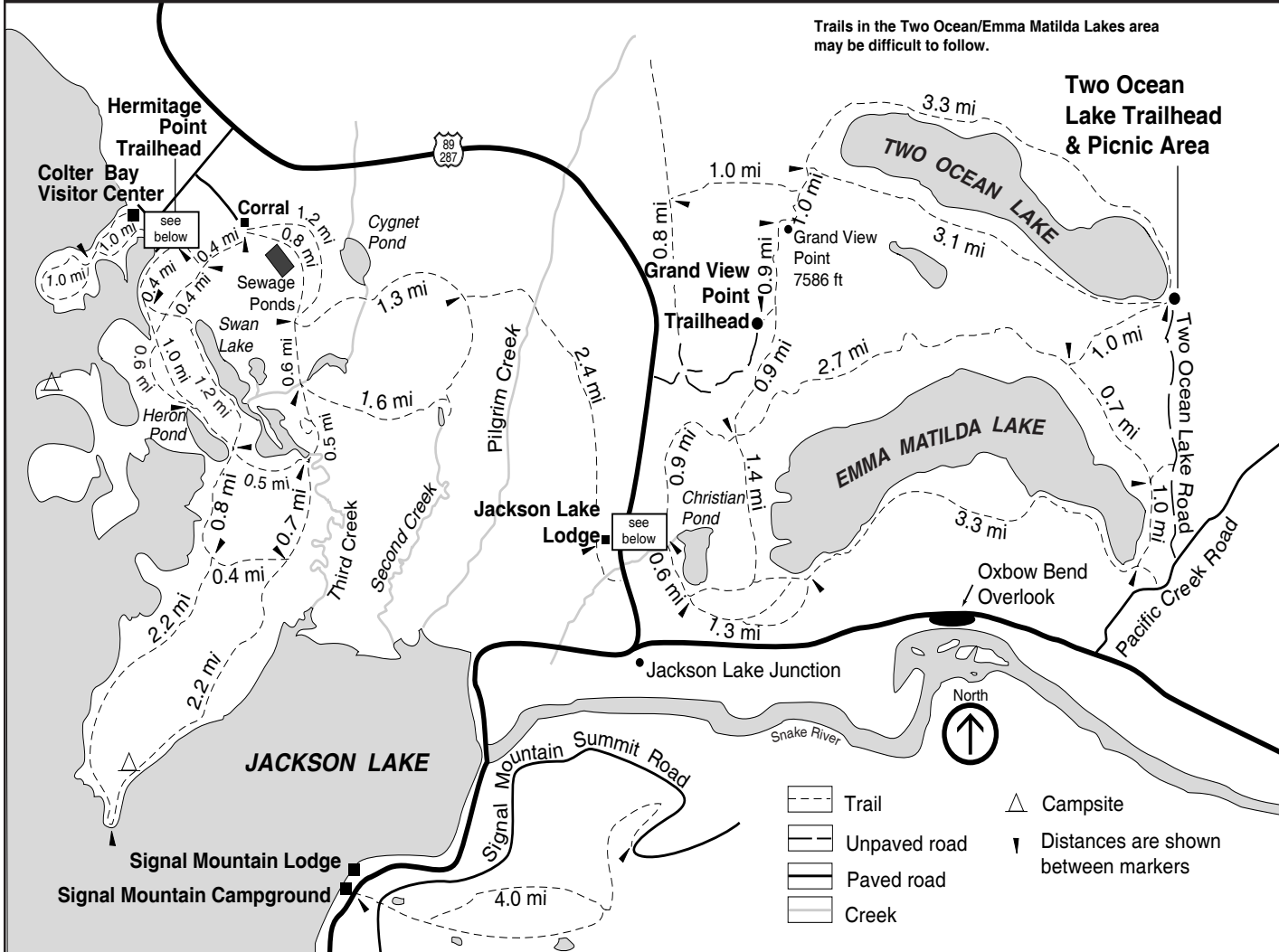
Bradley & Taggart Lakes



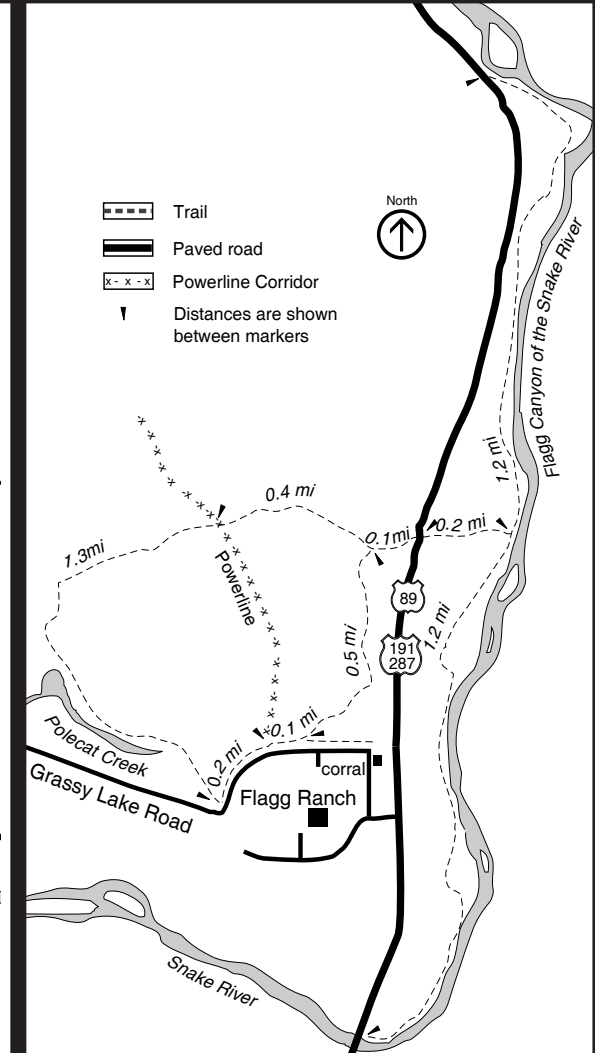
Phelps Lake



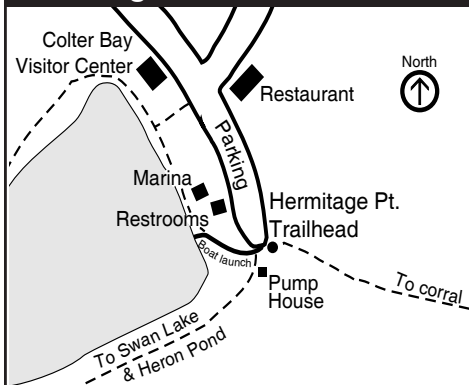
Hermitage Point, Two Ocean & Emma Matilda Lakes Trails



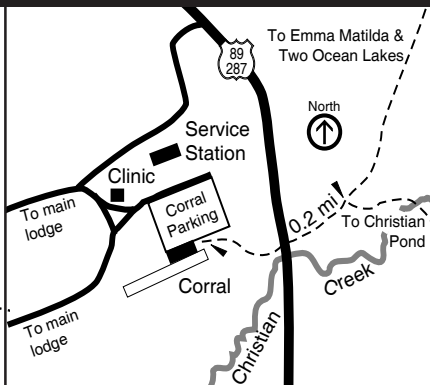
Flagg Ranch Area Trails

Backcountry Regulations

- Pets, weapons, bicycles or vehicles are **not** allowed on trails or in the backcountry.
- This is bear country. Make bears aware of your presence and avoid surprising them by making loud noises like shouting or singing.
- Respect wildlife: observe and photograph from a safe distance. Do not approach or feed animals.
- Hike on established trails to prevent erosion.
- Horses have the right-of-way. Step off the trail and remain quiet while horses pass.

Some Suggestions

During July and August, trailhead parking areas fill early in the day. An early start for your hike will avoid parking problems. Parking on natural vegetation results in permanent damage to plants; violators will be ticketed. In paved parking lots, parking illegally will also result in a ticket. If you can, please carpool. This will increase your chances of finding a parking space.
