A Bridge Between Two Worlds During the Revolutionary War a young Colonel Alexander Hamilton married Elizabeth Schuyler of New York. The wealthy and influential Schuyler family settled during the Dutch colonial period, and owned plantations with 10 to 30 slaves each. Hamilton had to reconcile his disapproval of slavery with his relationships of those close to him like the Schuylers, and George Washington.
