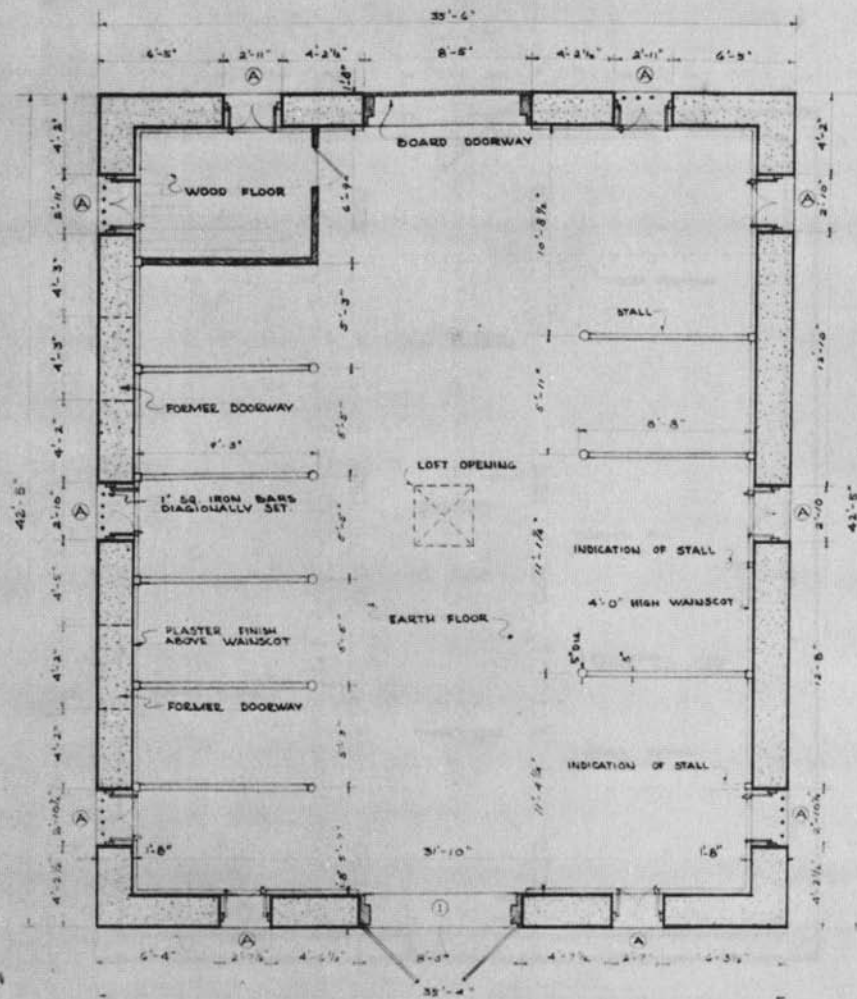


ALL WINDOWS FIRST FLOOR, 2.8A TYPE (A) SHUTTER

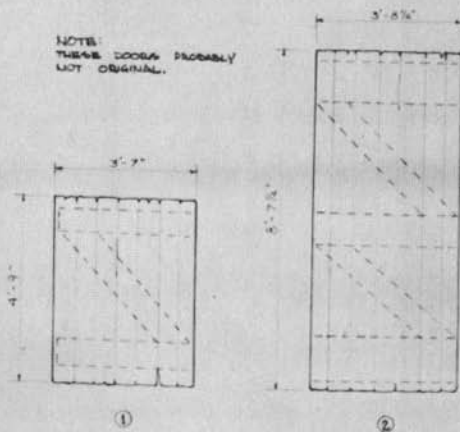


FIRST FLOOR PLAN

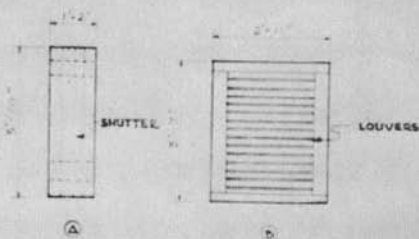
