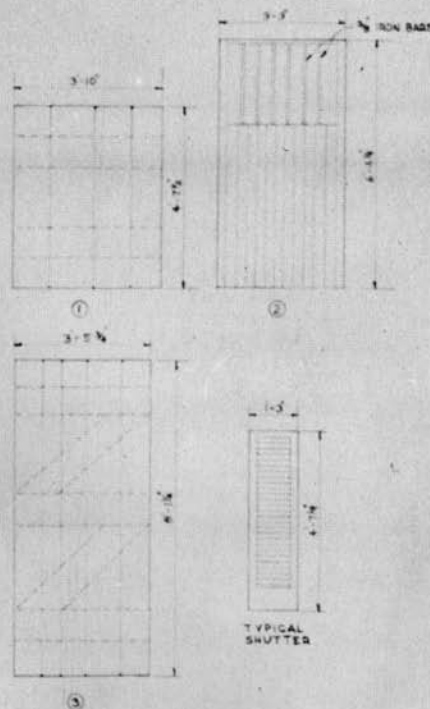


FIRST FLOOR PLAN
