

SECOND FLOOR PLAN

NOTE: THIS STRUCTURE IS ONE OF THREE SLAVE QUARTERS REMAINING ON HAMPTON PLANTATION, AND, ADJUSTING TO THE TIMES HAS MOST RECENTLY SERVED AS TENANT HOUSING. IT IS A SIMPLE STONE DURESS, ONE OF TWO SIMILAR BUILDINGS, MODIFIED WITH A TOWER IN THE BASEMENT AND PORCH TO THE REAR.

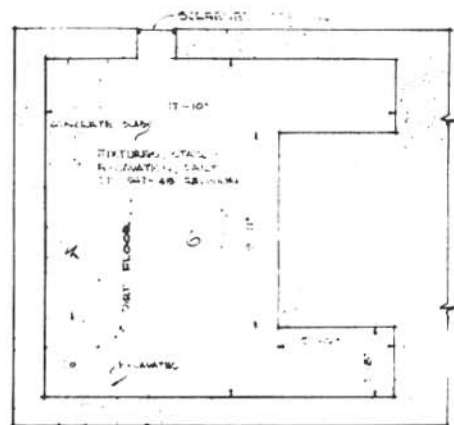

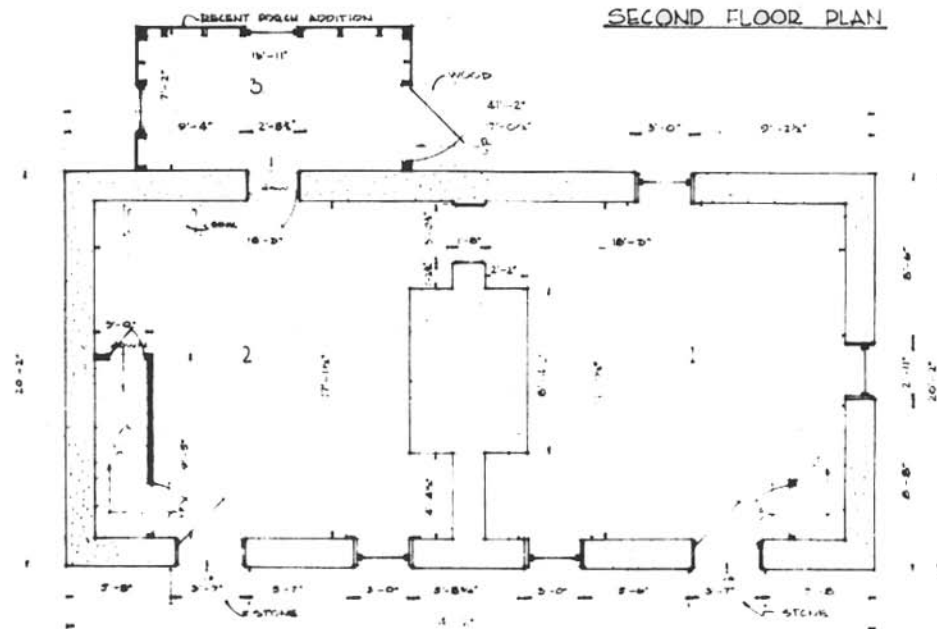


FLOOR PLANS
